A Reflection from Deacon Allan Frederiksen

REMEMBER TO KEEP HOLY THE SABBATH DAY

A number of words enter into our dictionary when it comes to fulfilling obligations: ACEDIA, meaning spiritual or mental sloth, and SLOTH, meaning a reluctance to work or fulfill an obligation, and we should not forget the word OBEDIENCE

meaning compliance with an order, request, or law or submission to another's authority.

Quotes in this short essay are from the Dictionary of Theology, unless otherwise noted, and are shown in *italics*.

In the Dictionary of Theology, we read "Contemporary Western Culture, with its dominant stress on individualism and personal freedom, often considers obedience a necessary evil. At best, obedience is a functional necessity in a complex society..."

Then the Dictionary continues in this manner: "Christian obedience, as developed in the Catholic tradition, differs from the above emphases."

The word obedience comes from *ob-audire* which means "to hear." *It denotes a willingness to hear others and to do their will. For the believer, obedience refers to hearing God, and obeying the divine will. The motivation for this submission is love for God.*

We find many references to obedience, so it is deeply rooted in scripture. The morality of both the OT and the NT is a morality of obedience. It is based on "You shall be my people and I will be your God" (Jer. 11:4)

In the NT we have the example of Jesus, and we should follow his example, because he not only *called for a deeper adherence to the spirit of the Law, but exemplified obedience in his own life, a life dedicated to do the Father's will.*

At our baptism we were baptized into a celebrating community, so we are not isolated individuals.

Obedience is a virtue, a consciously chosen docility to God's call in a variety of circumstances.

Keeping holy the sabbath day is an obligation, it is found in the 3rd Commandment, So, we have to look at the meaning of OBLIGATION.

In simple terms it is "a course of action which someone is required to take, whether a legal or moral obligation."

Obligations constrain us, they limit our freedom, or that is the common understanding.

Under ancient Roman Law obligations are the "bond of Vinculum Juris", or of legal necessity, between at least two or more individuals or parties.

Thus, we are under an obligation to keep Holy the Sabbath Day, because our obligation is between God and us.

Next time we will touch on how we, at times, look for ways to avoid fulfilling the obligation, and this is where acedia and sloth enters the picture.

COLOR GUARD

We encourage all Sir Knights to join our Color Guard. This core group represents the First District of Texas and is very dedicated. If you are able and willing, it is a very rewarding experience. SK Teddy Cuaping is a great Commander of the Color Guard.

PURPOSE OF THE COLOR CORPS OF THE FOURTH DEGREE

The primary purpose of the Fourth Degree is to encourage active Catholic citizenship and foster the spirit of patriotism in members and the community at large. The Color Corps members exemplify all the principles of our Order;

Charity- by the gift of their time and energies necessary to practice, perfect and perform the ceremonials and sword drill:

Unity- by the united efforts of Sir Knights to practice and perfect a coordinated drill for the good of the Church and the Order;

Fraternity- by expressing an "Esprit de Corps," sharing a common desire for drill excellence and camaraderie, and

Patriotism- by performing precision drill as a salute to God and to the country and visually exhibiting a love for both.

COLOR CORPS DESCRIPTION

The Color Corps (C.C.) has two sub-groups, the Color Guard (C.G.) and the Honor Guard (H.G.). The Color Guard consists of the flag bearers and at least two members of the Honor Guard who escorts the colors. The Honor Guard consists of members of the Color Corps who have mastered the Manual of the Sword.

In many assemblies, all members of the Color Corps belong to the Honor Guard. This should be kept in mind when following the procedures in the Color Corps Manual.

The public appearance of Fourth Degree knights as a Color Corps at religious and civic functions is an important activity for each assembly. They add dignity and the pride of Church and country to any event. By these public demonstrations their loyalties bring credit to themselves and to the Knights of Columbus.
