We conducted the annual Assembly audit following the last Assembly monthly meeting and submitted the Form 1315 *Annual Assembly Audit Report* to the Supreme and the District on August 1. The 2024 Fall Fourth Degree Exemplification will be held on October 12, 2024 at Saint Jude Thaddeus Catholic Church in Beaumont, Texas. Any Third Degree member of our Councils who wishes to become a Fourth Degree Sir Knight at the Fall Exemplification is required to complete the Fourth Degree Membership Document (Form-4) and a Candidate Registration form. Completed Form-4 must be submitted to the Assembly by October 2 for membership approval at the upcoming Assembly meetings. In addition, completed Candidate Registration including a check payable to "*The Knights of Columbus Assembly 2084*" for appropriate fees must be received by the Assembly Faithful Comptroller by October 4.

We will have two opportunities to attend Color Corps Sword Training and Protocols classes in early September. District Marshals and Assembly 2084 Color Corps Commanders will conduct a "private" sword training immediately after the Assembly monthly meeting on September 5. There will be a District-wide *Color Corps Sword Training and Protocols Class* held on Saturday, September 7, 2024 from 9:00 AM to noon at St. Laurence Catholic Church, Sugar Land. These trainings are open to all Sir Knights who seek to build up their sword handling skills and knowledge of protocols.

We are Fourth Degree Sir Knights of the Knights of Columbus. Let us be faithful to our Order, Church and Country. I would like to encourage all of our Sir Knights to become active members of the Color Corps and serve as the visible arm of our Order.



How do we keep Holy the Lord's Day?

For us to answer that question, we must connect some very widely scattered dots, which are mentioned below.

I am using the 1990 Edition of the NAB "Catholic Study Bible" and all quotes are from this edition. I recommend reading the

actual scripture passages shown, regardless of which translation/edition you may have.

We begin with the opening of the Book of Genesis, to the creation of the very beginning of time (Gen. 1:1-31). Several things are evident; God speaks, and it is! God speaks to the earth, the water, and the sky, and each produced and became fruitful. Then God speaks to himself, "*Let us make man in our image* ..." and mankind is created, with a specific duty. As a result, we may assume mankind to have a special place in the created order.

It is only after all the creative acts that God rests and in the act resting the sabbath – the Day of Rest – is created.

In the book of Exodus, we find the giving of the Ten Commandments, but the story begins with the "call of Moses" on Mount Horeb (Exodus 3). It continues in Exodus 12 with the establishment of the Passover Ritual, and the beginning of the Jewish Calendar, "This month shall stand at the head of your calendar, you shall reckon it the first month of the year" (Ex. 12:1-2). In chapter 16 of Exodus, we receive certain instructions regarding the food from heaven, Manna (Ex 16:16-19).

In chapter 20 we encounter the giving of the Ten Commandments; here we will focus on the first three.

"Then the Lord delivered all these commandments" Exodus 20:1-11.

- 1: "I the Lord, am your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, that place of slavery. You shall have no other Gods besides me..."
- 2: "You shall not take the name of the Lord, your God, in vain ..."

3: "Remember to keep holy the sabbath day, six days you may labor and do your work, but the seventh day is the sabbath of the Lord. ..."

What exactly does the word sabbath mean? We have the Jewish Sabbath which is from sunset Friday evening until sunset Saturday evening. We also have the Christian Sabbath, usually celebrated on Sundays, but since our religious roots are Jewish, we may say the Christian Sabbath begins at sunset on Saturday evening and ends at sunset on Sunday evening. This is the reason that parishes offer Vigil Masses on Saturday evenings, in many cases before the sun sets.

In the context of the Jewish understanding of the word, it essentially means the day on which a religious rest is enjoined, because it is the Seventh Day, the Day when God rested, and that is the premise we will work from.

COLOR GUARD

We encourage all Sir Knights to join our Color Guard. This core group represents the First District of Texas and is very dedicated. If you are able and willing, it is a very rewarding experience. SK Teddy Cuaping is a great Commander of the Color Guard.

PURPOSE OF THE COLOR CORPS OF THE FOURTH DEGREE

The primary purpose of the Fourth Degree is to encourage active Catholic citizenship and foster the spirit of patriotism in members and the community at large. The Color Corps members exemplify all the principles of our Order;

Charity- by the gift of their time and energies necessary to practice, perfect and perform the ceremonials and sword drill:

Unity- by the united efforts of Sir Knights to practice and perfect a coordinated drill for the good of the Church and the Order;

Fraternity- by expressing an "Esprit de Corps," sharing a common desire for drill excellence and camaraderie, and

Patriotism- by performing precision drill as a salute to God and to the country and visually exhibiting a love for both.

COLOR CORPS DESCRIPTION

The Color Corps (C.C.) has two sub-groups, the Color Guard (C.G.) and the Honor Guard (H.G.). The Color Guard consists of the flag bearers and at least two members of the Honor Guard who escorts the colors. The Honor Guard consists of members of the Color Corps who have mastered the Manual of the Sword.

In many assemblies, all members of the Color Corps belong to the Honor Guard. This should be kept in mind when following the procedures in the Color Corps Manual.

The public appearance of Fourth Degree knights as a Color Corps at religious and civic functions is an important activity for each assembly. They add dignity and the pride of Church and country to any event. By these public demonstrations their loyalties bring credit to themselves and to the Knights of Columbus.
