### A Message from Faithful Navigator Joseph Ch'ien

This month we celebrated Advent and Christmas. We held the Assembly 2084 Christmas Party and Family Dinner in the evening of December 3 at the Council 8960 Hall. Members brought their favorite dishes and desserts to share and donated toys to needy families of local parishes. This year the toys were sent to St. Luke's and Our Lady of Mount Carmel. The Patriotic Service Award for the Fraternal Year 2022-23 was presented. SK Bo Naguit, SK Craig Guth, PFN, SK Ed Klein, SK Jesse Canales and SK Gilbert Ramos are the recipients of this Award (see *Patriotic Service Award* section for details). During the month of December our Sir Knights participated in a total of ten District and local turnouts. We celebrated the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe with one District and three local turnouts. We also took part in local and District turnouts for Simbang Gabi, a traditional Filipino Advent celebration. Our Sir Knights served as Honor Guard at all three Archdiocesan Christmas Masses and at the Feast of Immaculate Conception Mass in the Diocese of Beaumont. Thank you Sir Knights for your support and service.

We are Fourth Degree Sir Knights of Knights of Columbus. Let us always be faithful to our Order, Church and Country. I would like to invite all Sir Knights to become an active part of the Fourth Degree Color Corps in honoring our Church and our Nation. Come and join us in serving as the Visible Arm of our Honored Order.

### Patriotic Service Award for Fraternal Year 2022-23 by Bill Prindiville, PFN, Faithful Purser

There were **100** possible turn-outs for Assembly #2084 members to participate during FY 2022-2023. SK's from #2084 participated in **93** (out of the 100) turn-outs or **93.0%** of all turn-outs. Only **7** turn-out (**7.0%** of total) lacked any SK participants from Assembly #2084.

There were a total of **556** individual turn-out participations from the Sir Knights of Assembly #2084. **38** SK's from #2084 participated in one or more turn-outs during this FY. The **38** SK's represent **14.8%** of Assembly #2084's total membership of **256** members. The **38** participating SK's averaged **14.6** turn-outs each during the FY.

14 SK's from #2084 participated in 12 or more (at least one per month) turn-outs during the FY, averaging 32.2 turn-outs for each of these 14 SK's. These 14 SK's (representing 5.5% of the Assembly membership) account for 451 of the 556 individual turn-out participations (or 81.1% of all turn-out participations).

24 SK's from #2084 who participated in less than "one Turn-Out per month" averaged only 4.4 turn-outs during the FY. These 24 SK's (representing 9.4% of the Assembly membership) account for 105 of the 556 individual turn-out participations (or 18.9% of all turn-out participations).

#### **COLOR GUARD**

We encourage all Sir Knights to join our Color Guard. This core group represents the First District of Texas and is very dedicated. If you are able and willing, it is a very rewarding experience. SK Teddy Cuaping is a great commander of the Color Guard.

#### PURPOSE OF THE COLOR CORPS OF THE FOURTH DEGREE

The primary purpose of the Fourth Degree is to encourage active Catholic citizenship and foster the spirit of patriotism in members and the community at large. The Color Corps members exemplify all the principles of our Order;

**Charity-** by the gift of their time and energies necessary to practice, perfect and perform the ceremonials and sword drill:

**Unity-** by the united efforts of Sir Knights to practice and perfect a coordinated drill for the good of the Church and the Order;

**Fraternity**- by expressing an "Esprit de Corps," sharing a common desire for drill excellence and camaraderie, and

**Patriotism-** by performing precision drill as a salute to God and to the country and visually exhibiting a love for both.

#### **COLOR CORPS DESCRIPTION**

The Color Corps (C.C.) has two sub-groups, the Color Guard (C.G.) and the Honor Guard (H.G.). The Color Guard consists of the flag bearers and at least two members of the Honor Guard who escorts the colors. The Honor Guard consists of members of the Color Corps who have mastered the Manual of the Sword.

In many assemblies, all members of the Color Corps belong to the Honor Guard. This should be kept in mind when following the procedures in the Color Corps Manual.

The public appearance of Fourth Degree knights as a Color Corps at religious and civic functions is an important activity for each assembly. They add dignity and the pride of Church and country to any event. By these public demonstrations their loyalties bring credit to themselves and to the Knights of Columbus.
