

SYNOD ON SYNODALITY



The Synod on Synodality is a two-year process of listening and dialogue beginning with the solemn opening in Rome on October 10, by Pope Francis. The synodal process will conclude in 2023. A synod is a conversation about who and what we are and what our experiences are.

Pope Francis invites the entire Church to reflect on a theme that is decisive for its life and mission: "It is precisely this path of Synodality which God expects of the Church of the third millennium." The Synod is a process of spiritual and ecclesial discernment, that unfolds in adoration, prayer and in dialogue with the word of God. Celebrating a Synod means walking on the same road, walking together.

This journey, which follows in the wake of the Church's "renewal" proposed by the Second Vatican Council is both a gift and a task. By journeying and reflecting together on the Church will be able to learn through Her experience, which processes can help Her to live communion, to achieve participation, to open Herself to mission. As we seek to encounter the Lord, you don't have to go across the sea. You don't have to look up or down. Jesus is right with you, in your minds and hearts, if we are attentive to His word before we start any conversation and then just see what happens. Synodal can be explained as simply walking the path of faith together. We do it through communion, participation, and mission. It is an opportunity for every Catholic to listen to one another but above all to the Holy Spirit. Let us take this opportunity to participate, engage and dialogue with our fellow Catholics. Let us also use other opportunities the diocese will be introducing.


All Souls Day Mass - November 2, 2021 (DISTRICT)

PURPOSE OF THE COLOR CORPS OF THE FOURTH DEGREE

The primary purpose of the Fourth Degree is to encourage active Catholic citizenship and foster the spirit of patriotism in members and the community at large. The Color Corps members exemplify all the principles of our Order;

Charity- by the gift of their time and energies necessary to practice, perfect and perform the ceremonials and sword drill:

Unity- by the united efforts of Sir Knights to practice and perfect a coordinated drill for the good of the Church and the Order;

Fraternity- by expressing an "Esprit de Corps," sharing a common desire for drill excellence and camaraderie, and

Patriotism- by performing precision drill as a salute to God and to the country and visually exhibiting a love for both.

COLOR CORPS DESCRIPTION

The Color Corps (C.C.) has two sub-groups, the Color Guard (C.G.) and the Honor Guard (H.G.). The Color Guard consists of the flag bearers and at least two members of the Honor

Guard who escorts the colors. The Honor Guard consists of members of the Color Corps who have mastered the Manual of the Sword.

In many assemblies, all members of the Color Corps belong to the Honor Guard. This should be kept in mind when following the procedures in the Color Corps Manual.

The public appearance of Fourth Degree knights as a Color Corps at religious and civic functions is an important activity for each assembly. They add dignity and the pride of Church and country to any event. By these public demonstrations their loyalties bring credit to themselves and to the Knights of Columbus.
