A Reflection from Deacon Allan Frederiksen

Recently I came across a quote that went something like this:

- The grandparents never missed a Sunday or any other Day of Obligation.
- The parents go to church on most Sundays.
- The children go to church occasionally, like Easter, Christmas, for weddings, baptisms, and funerals, and perhaps on Ash Wednesday.
- The grandchildren ask, "What is church?"

The global pandemic did serious damage to church attendance, with many churches being closed or only allowing limited attendance, as they, the churches, turned to live streaming the masses over the internet. Church goers began to watch, the key word being watch, "church" on their TV screens, but could not really participate in the liturgy.

Thus "church" took the form of entertainment on the screen.

The downfall being that many families / people never returned to church, having been able to "be at church" while comfortable at home, and they discovered that during those enforced months at home that on any given Sunday, or weekday for that matter, during the year there are many forms of entertainment available on TV; baseball, football, soccer, golf, tennis, comedy shows, movies, The list is very long. Some forms are more entertaining than others, and we are drawn to the one with the most entertainment value, which for me is _____ (fill in the blank).

Now, three plus years after the pandemic, we must ask ourselves, into what element are we drawn? The Mass on EWTN, or to the fast pace of a football game, with its tense moments; to the chewing and spitting artistry of a good baseball game; ...; as opposed to someone delivering lengthy monologues from a book, and droning out a monotonous homily, which perhaps makes us drowsy while sitting in the pew and causes dozing off while sitting comfortable on the couch at home.

We have ended up at this point, perhaps because of a failure to fully understand the liturgy, which means CCE classes, confirmation classes, the Church herself, never fully opened the richness of the liturgy for us. We were probably never told that we enter into very sacred space, not just physically, but in time – We stand with the Israelites in Egypt as they eat their first Passover meal; we are with them in the dessert when they complain to Moses they have nothing to eat, and they are given manna from heaven; we are with them on the day of Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem, which we now call Palm Sunday; we are with Jesus and his twelve apostles as they eat the Passover meal; we are with the two disciples in their little house in Emmaus, as they recognize the risen Christ in the breaking of the bread. In fact, we journey from Egypt, certainly from Mount Sinai to Golgotha.

Next month we will look at the worship space itself, and what it should be, and what we see today.

COLOR GUARD

We encourage all Sir Knights to join our Color Guard. This core group represents the First District of Texas and is very dedicated. If you are able and willing, it is a very rewarding experience. SK Teddy Cuaping is a great Commander of the Color Guard.

PURPOSE OF THE COLOR CORPS OF THE FOURTH DEGREE

The primary purpose of the Fourth Degree is to encourage active Catholic citizenship and foster the spirit of patriotism in members and the community at large. The Color Corps members exemplify all the principles of our Order;

Charity- by the gift of their time and energies necessary to practice, perfect and perform the ceremonials and sword drill:

Unity- by the united efforts of Sir Knights to practice and perfect a coordinated drill for the good of the Church and the Order;

Fraternity- by expressing an "Esprit de Corps," sharing a common desire for drill excellence and camaraderie, and

Patriotism- by performing precision drill as a salute to God and to the country and visually exhibiting a love for both.

COLOR CORPS DESCRIPTION

The Color Corps (C.C.) has two sub-groups, the Color Guard (C.G.) and the Honor Guard (H.G.). The Color Guard consists of the flag bearers and at least two members of the Honor Guard who escorts the colors. The Honor Guard consists of members of the Color Corps who have mastered the Manual of the Sword.

In many assemblies, all members of the Color Corps belong to the Honor Guard. This should be kept in mind when following the procedures in the Color Corps Manual.

The public appearance of Fourth Degree knights as a Color Corps at religious and civic functions is an important activity for each assembly. They add dignity and the pride of Church and country to any event. By these public demonstrations their loyalties bring credit to themselves and to the Knights of Columbus.
