 - o Funds in and paid out for 5th grade events.
 - o Funds came in from All Pro Dads event, Got Sneakers, The Complex, Yearbook sales and my payments plus which was the last check of the year and included festival funds.
 - o Funds came in from the kindergarten sign sales and the new line item has been added.
