

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY. THIS AGREEMENT AFFECTS YOUR LEGAL RIGHTS.

In consideration for being permitted to enter, participate in, attend, or otherwise take part in any competition, roping, practice, activity, or related function produced, promoted, sanctioned, or conducted by Masters Tour LLC (collectively, the "Event"), I, the undersigned contestant, and, when applicable, my parent or legal guardian, acknowledge and agree to the following:

1. CONDUCT

Participation in the Masters Tour and all related events and activities is entirely voluntary. By entering, attending, competing in, or otherwise participating in a Masters Tour event, you agree to conduct yourself in a professional, respectful, and sportsmanlike manner toward Masters Tour management, staff, officials, sponsors, contractors, facility personnel, fellow contestants, spectators, and all other persons associated with the event. Abusive, threatening, disruptive, unsafe, unsportsmanlike, or disrespectful conduct, or failure to comply with event rules or directives, may result in immediate disqualification and removal from the property, without refund. The Masters Tour events are produced at privately owned facilities, and participation and continued presence on the property are subject to the rules and requirements of both Masters Tour producers and the facility owner or operator. The mission of the Masters Tour is to provide a competitive platform where ropers of all ages and ability levels can participate while promoting fairness, consistency, efficiency, good sportsmanship, and the highest level of respect for our ropers, partners, sponsors, personnel, and facilities.

2. ASSUMPTION OF RISK

I understand and acknowledge that rodeo, roping, equine, livestock, and competitive athletic activities are inherently dangerous and involve risks that cannot be completely eliminated regardless of the care taken to avoid injury.

Such risks include, but are not limited to, the unpredictable behavior of horses and livestock; falls; kicks; bites; collisions; ropes; barriers; gates; arena equipment; arena and ground conditions; other contestants; spectators; vehicles; trailers; equipment; weather conditions; and the acts or omissions of other persons.

I knowingly and voluntarily assume all risks of bodily injury, illness, disability, death, property damage, financial loss, or other loss arising from or related to my participation in or presence at the Event, whether such risks are known or unknown, foreseeable or unforeseeable, to the fullest extent permitted by law.

3. RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY

To the fullest extent permitted by applicable law, I hereby release, waive, discharge, and covenant not to sue Masters Tour LLC, its owners, members, officers, directors, managers, employees, agents, contractors, volunteers, representatives, sponsors, affiliates, event producers, stock contractors, arena personnel, property owners, venue owners and operators, and each of their respective officers, employees, agents, representatives, successors, and assigns (collectively, the "Released Parties") for claims arising from or related to my participation in or presence at the Event.

This release is intended to apply to claims involving personal injury, death, illness, property damage, financial loss, or other damages to the fullest extent such claims may lawfully be released or waived in advance.

4. INDEMNIFICATION AND HOLD HARMLESS

To the fullest extent permitted by applicable law, I agree to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the Released Parties from claims, liabilities, damages, losses, costs, or expenses,

including reasonable attorneys' fees, arising from my acts or omissions, my horse or other property, or my violation of Event rules.

5. EQUINE ACTIVITY ACKNOWLEDGMENT

I specifically acknowledge and accept the inherent risks associated with horses, livestock, rodeo, and roping activities.

Horses and livestock may behave unpredictably regardless of their training, experience, temperament, or prior behavior. I accept responsibility for determining whether I, and any horse I ride, handle, or bring to the Event, are physically and mentally capable of safely participating.

6. FORCE MAJEURE, EVENT CHANGES & CANCELLATION

I acknowledge that circumstances beyond the reasonable control of Masters Tour LLC may affect an Event.

Masters Tour LLC shall not be responsible or liable for delays, postponements, cancellations, interruptions, schedule changes, venue changes, inability to conduct all or any portion of an Event, or other consequences resulting from circumstances beyond its reasonable control.

Such circumstances may include, without limitation, acts of God; severe or dangerous weather; fire; flood; natural disaster; epidemic, pandemic, or public-health emergency; governmental orders, regulations, restrictions, or actions; labor disputes; utility failures; transportation interruptions; acts or threats of terrorism or violence; civil disturbances; venue unavailability; livestock-related circumstances; equipment or infrastructure failure outside the reasonable control of Masters Tour LLC; or other force majeure events.

I understand and agree that Masters Tour LLC may reasonably modify schedules, start times, arenas, formats, locations, added money, prizes, payouts, competition procedures, or other Event details when circumstances make such changes necessary or appropriate.

7. ENTRY FEES, WITHDRAWALS, CANCELLATIONS & ROPER ADMINISTRATION FEE

I understand that my entry constitutes a commitment to participate and that Masters Tour LLC may incur expenses and make competition arrangements in reliance upon submitted entries.

Cancellations received on or before November 15, 2026 will incur a flat \$25 cancellation fee.

Cancellations received after November 15, 2026 will incur a flat \$100 cancellation fee.

The applicable cancellation fee will be deducted from any refund otherwise due to the contestant.

The \$25 Roper Administration Fee and credit card usage fees is nonrefundable and will not be included in any refund or credit issued to the contestant.

Failure to compete, voluntary withdrawal, travel difficulties, transportation problems, scheduling conflicts, horse injury or illness, contestant injury or illness, failure to satisfy eligibility requirements, disqualification, or other circumstances personal to the contestant do not waive the applicable cancellation fee or entitle the contestant to a refund of the \$25 Roper Administration Fee.

If an Event is postponed, relocated, modified, interrupted, or canceled because of a force majeure event or circumstances beyond the reasonable control of Masters Tour LLC, any refund, credit, rescheduling, or other accommodation will be determined by Masters Tour LLC consistent with applicable law and the circumstances affecting the Event. The \$25 Roper Administration Fee and any credit card processing fee remains nonrefundable.

8. RULES, ELIGIBILITY & DISQUALIFICATION

I certify that all information submitted with my registration, including my name, date of birth, birth year, eligibility information, classification or division information, and entry selections, is true and accurate.

I understand that it is my responsibility to satisfy the eligibility requirements for every division or roping I enter. The Masters Tour follows USTRC/World Series classifications; however, management expressly reserves the right to review, adjust, assign, or issue a contestant classification when the Management determines that circumstances warrant such action in the interest of fair competition.

Masters Tour LLC reserves the right to verify contestant eligibility and classification and to refuse, cancel, or disqualify an entry that does not meet applicable Event rules or eligibility requirements.

Submission or acceptance of an entry does not constitute a determination by Masters Tour LLC that the contestant is eligible for the selected division.

9. MINOR CONTESTANTS

If the contestant is under 18 years of age, this agreement must also be accepted and electronically signed by the contestant's parent or legal guardian.

The parent or legal guardian acknowledges the risks described in this agreement, consents to the minor contestant's participation, and agrees to the provisions of this agreement on behalf of the parent or legal guardian and, to the extent permitted by applicable law, on behalf of the minor contestant.

10. PHOTO, VIDEO, LIVESTREAM & MEDIA RELEASE

I authorize Masters Tour LLC and its authorized representatives to photograph, film, record, livestream, broadcast, or otherwise capture my name, image, likeness, voice, performance, and participation at the Event.

I grant Masters Tour LLC permission to use such materials in connection with Event coverage, promotion, advertising, social media, websites, broadcasts, publications, archival materials, and other lawful promotional or commercial purposes without additional compensation, unless prohibited by applicable law.

11. PERSONAL PROPERTY

I understand that I am responsible for my horses, tack, equipment, vehicles, trailers, personal belongings, and other property brought to or used in connection with the Event.

To the fullest extent permitted by law, Masters Tour LLC and the Released Parties are not responsible for lost, stolen, misplaced, damaged, or unattended property.

12. ELECTRONIC SIGNATURE & ACKNOWLEDGMENT

I acknowledge that I have been provided the opportunity to read this entire agreement before accepting or signing it.

By checking the required acceptance box and providing my electronic signature, I affirm:

I HAVE READ AND UNDERSTAND THIS PARTICIPANT AGREEMENT, RELEASE OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, FORCE MAJEURE PROVISION, CANCELLATION POLICY, ROPER ADMINISTRATION FEE POLICY, AND MEDIA RELEASE. I UNDERSTAND THAT THIS AGREEMENT AFFECTS CERTAIN LEGAL RIGHTS, AND I VOLUNTARILY AGREE TO BE BOUND BY ITS TERMS.

I agree that my electronic signature is intended to constitute my legal signature and consent to the use of electronic records and signatures in connection with this registration.

13. GOVERNING LAW, SEVERABILITY & ENTIRE AGREEMENT

This agreement shall be governed by and interpreted under the laws of the State of Nevada, without regard to conflict-of-law principles, to the extent applicable.

If any provision of this agreement is determined to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable, that provision shall be enforced to the maximum extent permitted by law, and the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

This agreement, together with the applicable Event rules and registration terms, constitutes the agreement between the contestant and Masters Tour LLC concerning the matters addressed herein. No waiver or modification is effective unless authorized by Masters Tour LLC.
