My name is Korina, and I started Roots of Resistance because I know what it feels like to live through injustice without having the words to name it.

As a young Latina woman, I didn't truly learn about systemic racism, classism, elitism, socialization, liberation education, and more until college and grad school; and even then, the language often felt out of reach.

Finding that vocabulary changed my life. It helped me make sense of my own experiences, and it showed me that the systems holding us down are not natural — they are built, and they can be resisted.
