

Lessons in Life -- Lesson 12 – God Comes to Eden: Part 3

Introduction: Re-read Genesis 3:1-10. In this lesson we look at 3:11 where God continues His conversation with Adam.

Read this passage at least five times then answer the questions as best you can:

¹¹ And He said, "Who told you that you *were* naked? Have you eaten from the tree of which I commanded you that you should not eat?" (Gen. 3:11 NKJ)

In 3:11 God asks Adam two questions. What is the first question?

That question is not answered directly in the text. How did Adam know that he was naked? What voice spoke to Adam?

Romans 2:14-16 tells us about that voice. What is the name of that voice? Who has that voice?

What does that voice speak about? What is written in every man's heart? Who wrote it there?

What law is Paul talking about? Read Exodus 20:1-20 for a summary of that law.

Who outside of a person uses the law written on the heart to convict a person's conscience?

Do you hear that voice? What is God speaking through your conscience saying to you? (You do not need to write that answer here. Take that answer to God in prayer. Remember that God is near to the humble.)
