

## Lessons in Life -- Lesson 8 – Sin Comes to Eden-Part 5

**Introduction:** In Genesis 3:6-7 we saw in the last lesson that the original sin was a lust to be God. In this lesson we will focus on Adam's part in this and the consequences of his sin.

**Read this passage at least five times then answer the questions as best you can:**

<sup>6</sup> So when the woman saw that the tree *was* good for food, that it *was* pleasant to the eyes, and a tree desirable to make *one* wise, she took of its fruit and ate. She also gave to her husband with her, and he ate.

<sup>7</sup> Then the eyes of both of them were opened, and they knew that they *were* naked; and they sewed fig leaves together and made themselves coverings. (Gen. 3:6-7 NKJ)

Re-read Genesis 2:15-17. To whom did God give this instruction?

Who was responsible for telling Eve about this?

Whose duty was it to protect his God-given helper?

Explain Adam's failure as the spiritual leader of his marriage?

Give one example of how you have followed in Adam's footsteps.

Read Romans 5. Who is the first Adam? What did he do?

Who is the second Adam? What did he do?

Re-read Romans 5:1-5. Do you have peace with God through Christ? If not, would you pray and confess your sins to God and ask Him to give you that peace?

How does God demonstrate His love for us (Romans 5:8)?

Think of someone in your pod or family that you need to show that kind of love. Pray that God will help you love as He loved you.
