<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>9</sup> If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>10</sup> If we say that we have not sinned, we make Him a liar, and His word is not in us (1 Jn. 1:7-10 NKJ)

My son, do not forget my law, But let your heart keep my commands; <sup>2</sup> For length of days and long life

And peace they will add to you.

- <sup>3</sup> Let not mercy and truth forsake you; Bind them around your neck,
- Write them on the tablet of your heart,
- <sup>4</sup> And so find favor and high esteem In the sight of God and man.
- Trust in the LORD with all your heart,
   And lean not on your own understanding;
   In all your ways acknowledge Him,
   And He shall direct your paths.
- Do not be wise in your own eyes;
   Fear the LORD and depart from evil.
   It will be health to your flesh,

And strength to your bones.

- <sup>9</sup> Honor the LORD with your possessions, And with the firstfruits of all your increase;
- <sup>10</sup> So your barns will be filled with plenty, And your vats will overflow with new wine.
- <sup>11</sup> My son, do not despise the chastening of the LORD,

Nor detest His correction;

- <sup>12</sup> For whom the LORD loves He corrects, Just as a father the son *in whom* he delights.
- <sup>13</sup> Happy *is* the man *who* finds wisdom, And the man *who* gains understanding; <sup>14</sup> For her proceeds *are* better than the profits of silver,

And her gain than fine gold.

- <sup>15</sup> She *is* more precious than rubies, And all the things you may desire cannot compare with her.
- <sup>16</sup> Length of days *is* in her right hand, In her left hand riches and honor.
- <sup>17</sup> Her ways *are* ways of pleasantness, And all her paths *are* peace.
- <sup>18</sup> She *is* a tree of life to those who take hold of her,

And happy are all who retain her.

- <sup>2</sup> They will help you live for many years. They will bring you success.

- Trust in the LORD with all your heart.
   Do not depend on your own understanding.

- <sup>7</sup> Don't be wise in your own eyes. Have respect for the LORD and avoid evil.
- <sup>8</sup> That will bring health to your body.

It will make your bones strong.

- <sup>9</sup> Honor the LORD with your wealth. Give him the first share of all your crops.
- <sup>10</sup> Then your storerooms will be so full they can't hold everything.

Your huge jars will spill over with fresh wine.

- <sup>11</sup> My son, do not hate the LORD's training. Do not object when he corrects you.
- <sup>12</sup> The LORD trains those he loves. He is like a father who trains the son he is pleased with.
- <sup>13</sup> Blessed is the one who finds wisdom. Blessed is the one who gains understanding.
- <sup>14</sup> Wisdom pays better than silver does. She earns more than gold does.
- <sup>15</sup> She is worth more than rubies. Nothing you want can compare with her.
- <sup>16</sup> Long life is in her right hand. In her left hand are riches and honor.
- <sup>17</sup> Her ways are pleasant ways.

All her paths lead to peace.

- <sup>18</sup> She is a tree of life to those who hold her close.
- Those who hold on to her will be blessed.

<sup>19</sup> The LORD by wisdom founded the earth; By understanding He established the heavens;

<sup>20</sup> By His knowledge the depths were broken up,

And clouds drop down the dew.

<sup>21</sup> My son, let them not depart from your eyes—

Keep sound wisdom and discretion; <sup>22</sup> So they will be life to your soul

And grace to your neck.

- <sup>23</sup> Then you will walk safely in your way, And your foot will not stumble.
- <sup>24</sup> When you lie down, you will not be afraid; Yes, you will lie down and your sleep will be sweet.
- <sup>25</sup> Do not be afraid of sudden terror, Nor of trouble from the wicked when it comes;
- <sup>26</sup> For the LORD will be your confidence, And will keep your foot from being caught.
- <sup>27</sup> Do not withhold good from those to whom it is due,

When it is in the power of your hand to do so.

<sup>28</sup> Do not say to your neighbor,

"Go, and come back,

And tomorrow I will give it,"

When you have it with you.

- <sup>29</sup> Do not devise evil against your neighbor, For he dwells by you for safety's sake.
- <sup>30</sup> Do not strive with a man without cause, If he has done you no harm.
- <sup>31</sup> Do not envy the oppressor, And choose none of his ways;
- <sup>32</sup> For the perverse *person is* an abomination to the LORD,

But His secret counsel is with the upright.

<sup>33</sup> The curse of the LORD *is* on the house of the wicked,

But He blesses the home of the just.

<sup>19</sup> By wisdom the LORD laid the earth's foundations.

Through understanding he set the heavens in place.

- <sup>20</sup> By his knowledge the seas were separated, and the clouds dropped their dew.
- <sup>21</sup> My son, hold on to good sense and the understanding of what is right.

  Don't let them out of your sight.

<sup>22</sup> They will be life for you.

They will be like a gracious necklace around your neck.

- <sup>23</sup> Then you will go on your way in safety. You will not trip and fall.
- <sup>24</sup> When you lie down, you won't be afraid. When you lie down, you will sleep soundly.
- <sup>25</sup> Don't be terrified by sudden trouble. Don't be afraid when sinners are destroyed.
- <sup>26</sup> The LORD is the one you will trust in. He will keep your feet from being caught in a trap.
- <sup>27</sup> Don't hold back good from those who are worthy of it.

Don't hold it back when you can help.

<sup>28</sup> Suppose you have something to give.

Don't say to your neighbor,

"Come back later.

I'll give it to you tomorrow."

<sup>29</sup> Don't plan to harm your neighbor.

He lives near you and trusts you.

<sup>30</sup> Don't bring charges against a man without any reason.

He has not harmed you.

- <sup>31</sup> Don't be jealous of a man who hurts others. Don't choose any of his ways.
- <sup>32</sup> The LORD really hates sinful people. But he makes honest people his closest friends.
- <sup>33</sup> The LORD puts a curse on the houses of sinners.

But he blesses the homes of those who do what is right.

<sup>34</sup> Surely He scorns the scornful,	<sup>34</sup> He laughs at proud people who make fun
But gives grace to the humble.	of others.
<sup>35</sup> The wise shall inherit glory,	But he gives grace to those who are not
But shame shall be the legacy of fools.	proud.
