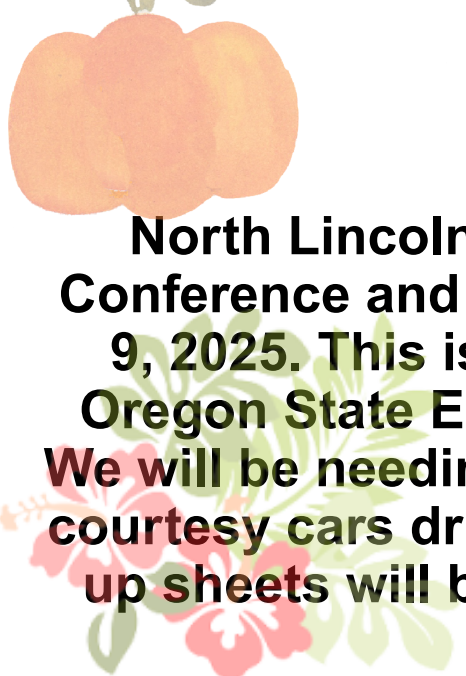

Mid-Winter Conference

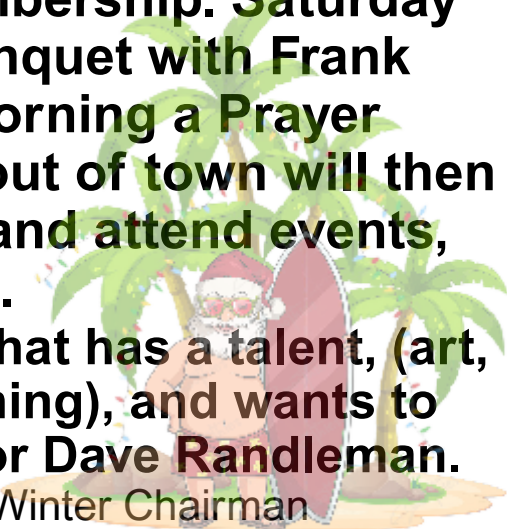
