Medical Fundraiser for Traci Oliver September 19th 1 PM -4 PM

**Here is her plea for help with her story:
Friends and family I have been pretty quiet
about my medical issues this past year and
honestly it is probably because I have been
trying to process it all myself....one year
ago I went to the mayo clinic in Arizona. On
my way to the airport I became extremely
sick I honestly thought I was going to die...
since then I have never been the same.**

**What was suppose to be a one week trip turned into 3 months....of hospital stays
and a rehab center I was diagnosed with severe gastroperisis along with many
more minor issues....the trip home was very long having to stop every couple
hours so I could throw up and in car I slept most of the trip or cried in pain... this
past year hasn't gotten any better... besides my chronic kidney failure and dialysis
the gastroperisis has gotten worse. I am now on a feeding tube to get most of my
nutrients and spend most of my time either sleeping, crying in pain and in the
hospital...So Oregon doctors have come to the conclusion there is nothing more
they can do for the stomach issues and I need to return to the mayo clinic... So in
October my mom and I will make the trip again in hopes for more answers and to
work with my other doctors down there so that I can work towards also getting a
kidney transplant... with all that being said I am on disability and unfortunately
need help to pay for this trip... these trips become costly with all the traveling
expenses and I cannot not carry the load by myself or leave the weight of this for
my immediate family...so if you feel lead to help please consider sending through
cash app so that I don't have to lose money through a go fund me. Thank you for
reading this and for considering helping me on this journey... May God Bless you
all....**
