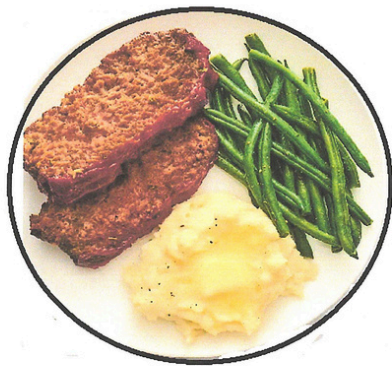
EVRs help remind everyone that the Fraternal Order of Eagles is much more than just a social club — we are a service-driven organization dedicated to helping others and strengthening our communities.

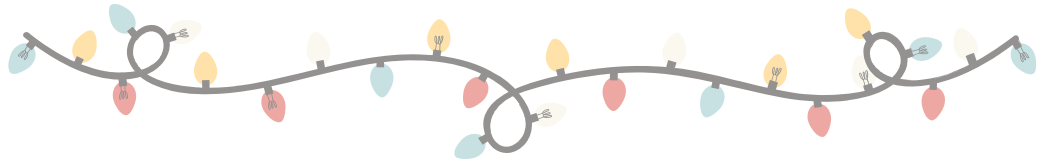

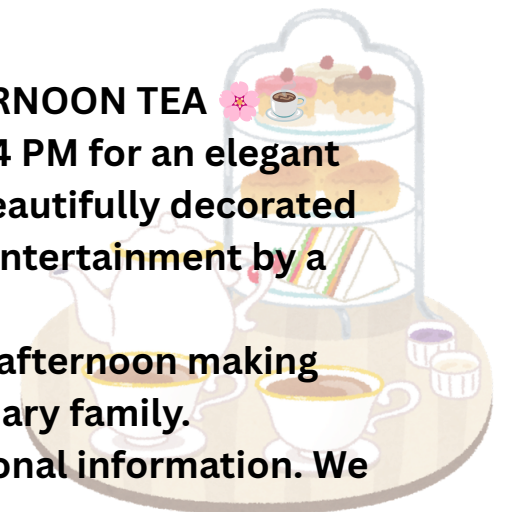
