2025 Rules & Fees

Stalls and Tack Stalls - \$70 each. No arrivals before 3PM Friday. Reserve and Pay for stalls at AshlandPaintAndPlain.com Stalls will not be reserved without payment.

Office Fee: \$10 per Horse

Entry Fees: Regular Classes: \$7.00 - 6 Placings;

\$100 Classes: \$10 (12 entries – \$40, \$25, \$15, \$10, \$10) Less than 12 entries: (40%, 20%, 10%, 5%, 5% - 6 placings, 5 payouts; \$500 class: \$20 (25 entries - \$225, \$100, \$75, \$60, \$40) Less than 25 entries: (40%, 20%, 10%, 5%, 5% - 6 placings, 5 payouts,

-Payment – No refunds of entry fees/stall fees/camping fees for any reason including vet excuse or scratches. Open checks are accepted. Once you enter a class, the entry fee will be added to your check even if you scratch the class. You must either pay in cash or leave a signed check with the entry booth. Credit cards now accepted (processing fees apply).

Cross Enter Rules:

Cross Entering between W/T & W/T/C will be by discipline.

Disciplines are: Showmanship, Western Pleasure, Horsemanship, Trail, Hunter Under Saddle, Equitation, & Ranch Example: You may W/T/C in Hunter Under Saddle and W/T in Western Pleasure, but you may not W/T and W/T/C in Western Pleasure.

- -Schooling Class (6 & 53) No placings. \$7 entry fee at booth. Safe attire required. Training aids/leg wraps are optional.
- -Showmanship All classes will run first come, first serve. Exhibitors will exit the arena upon completion of the pattern.
- -Reining and Ranch Horse Classes (28-40) These classes are open, and exhibitors may cross enter their horses between Pleasure, Ranch Horse Classes, and Reining. Use of hoof black, bands, false tails, and show tack is not required for Reining and Ranch.

-High Point Rules-

- 1. Exhibitors must be members in good standing of Ashland Paint & Plain Saddle Club.
- 2. You or a representative may purchase 1 sponsor per class to earn extra points for that class. You MUST indicate the class to be sponsored. Each sponsorship is worth 3 points toward the designated class. These must be purchased by the end of the last show of the season.
- 3. Points are as follows: 1st Place 6 points, 2nd Place 5 points, 3rd Place 4 points, 4th Place 3 points, 5th Place 2 points, 6th Place 1 point. Add 3 points for class sponsor.
- 4. Ties will be broken by the greatest number of 1st, 2nd, etc. August Show will be the tie breaker show.
- 5. Each class will have one champion and one reserve champion.
- 6. Inquiries on your point totals will only be accepted in writing and must include a SASE. No exceptions and no phone calls. Inquiries can be mailed to our point secretary, Susie Weber.
- 7. The Board of Directors, whose decision will be final, will act upon any issue that cannot be resolved by the point committee.

Ashland Paint & Plain reserves the right to split, combine or cancel any class based on number of class entries.
