

Arkansa Victory Challenge Update

Exhibitors and Friends of AAHC,

I am writing you today with great news! Per the Arkansas Governor's directive today, we are able to

have our Victory Challenge Horse Show, May 15-17 th in Texarkana, AR at the Four States Fairgrounds.

We are grateful to the Four States staff for their direction during this time. Some definite guidelines that will be in place:

- 1. Must practice social distancing.
- 2. Must have face coverings on while at the facility, this currently includes while riding and

showing. The AAHC will provide face masks but we recommend you bring your own as well. We

are working to make them as comfortable as possible.

3. We cannot have anyone enter the fairgrounds that resides in a state with a current stay at home

order.

There will be many changes to the normalcy of our show routine. I ask you to bear with us as we

navigate these new guidelines and have some patience if things are not going as smoothly as usual.

Right now, we need a few things from you if you plan on showing at the horse show.

1. Please send our barn manager and show secretary your stall count as soon as possible. We

need stall counts by May 8 th if at all possible. Please also let Clair and Beth know how many

shavings you would like to pre-order. Their contact information will be at the bottom of this

letter.

2. Please send your entries in to Beth, our show secretary, as soon as possible. If you are mailing

them, we need them post marked by May 6 th. If you are emailing the entries in,

please do so by

May 8 th . We are waiving post entry fees, but please be mindful that Beth is also working under

new guidelines so she will need extra time to process entries.

I will be publishing our new guidelines within the next 24 hours and also posting some good hotel

options on the Texas side of Texarkana. Restaurants on both the Arkansas and Texas side should be

open and operational.

Some additional changes for the horse show include:

Judges: Liz Bentley (MO) and Katie Hart (OK)

Jackets will be optional for the entire horse show in order to keep exhibitors cool and comfortable.

Thank you for your continued support and cooperation. We are working tirelessly to give you the best

experience possible to show your horse. If you have any questions or concerns, please reach out to me
