Dear Region 9 AHA Exhibitors and Members,

I know you all our probably getting a little tired of all the updates concerning the Region 9 Show, but we need to keep you advised of what is happening.

The WRMC notified us that the show following our show has cancelled, so this is allowing us to have use of all the arenas and barns we would have had for the May dates. Because of the shows before us, the "Move In" date is still Monday, June 15th , *as we will not have access to the Barnett Stalls (Premium stalls in Coliseum building\*) and the Richardson-Bass stalls.* The shows before us are using these two barns/stalls and they will have to be cleaned after the shows move out. Any questions regarding stalls should be directed to Steve Buddin, Show Manager at (228)238-0876.

While we will have the barns we normally have at this show, we still have the “COVID-19 Health & Safety Protocols” the facility will have in place for barns/stalling at the show we will have to follow. These barn/stalling requirements include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Stalls will be assigned to allow for physical distancing between farms, trainers or owners. Multiple assignments on the same aisle should have alternate access points to eliminate the need for cross traffic.
- Schedule horse arrivals and departures as much as

- Limited seating areas at the stalls/barns to limit congregating.  
\*Grooms and barn staff are **prohibited** from sleeping in horse stalls/barns. (Recommend the use of cameras in barn areas.)
- No cooking

We will have the total list of “Requirements and Best Practices” out soon.

Now, the next good news is that the schedule has been revised so that the Main ring classes will be held in the Coliseum starting Wednesday, June 17th and ending on Saturday, June 20th - all days and session times remain the same as last schedule. Working Western and Sport Horse & Dressage classes will be held in John Justin Arena, the Multi-Purpose Arenas and the Watt Arena, Tuesday, June 16th – Thursday, June 18th - all days and session times remain the same except the Western Dressage on Tuesday will have a start time of “Not before 2:00 PM” instead of 8:00 AM; and Western Trail on Tuesday will have a start time of “1 hour after Reining, but not before 3:00 PM” instead of 12:00 PM. \*For those wanting to have the Premium stalls in the Will Rogers/Burnett Building, you will need to follow guidelines found on Page 31 of the original Prize Book. You will be able to get the Patron Memberships at the early bird pricing until May 29th , after that the package prices will increase by \$100. Registration Form can be found at the bottom of the Patrons page, click on the “2020 Revised Registration Form” box to download and print. The “2020 Revised Patron Info” box lets you know what changes have been made to the packages due to COVID-19. You can also go to Region website, click on “Championship Horse Show”, “Patrons” and “Form” to fill out the online Registration and pay with PayPal. This fillable form is from the May dates so it is not up-to-date like the mail-in form, but should still be usable. The online form and PayPal would be the best way to make sure your Registration/Payment gets to Cindy by May 29th deadline.
