

Youth and Amateur HI-Point Program Region 9

The Youth and Amateur Hi-Point for Region 9 was developed to reward Youth and Amateurs who own/lease or have access to Arabians and Half Arabians. Participants must reside within the Region 9 borders. This program not only rewards those who show at the Class A, Community and One Day shows, but those who show at any Open Show (including 4-H Shows) within the Region. Even if the individual doesn't show in the ring, there is a category for Competitive and Endurance Riding, as well as Recreational Riding which encompasses daily pleasure riding and just having a great

time with your horse!

The program honors those Champion, Reserve and Top Five placing in the following Categories:

English/ Country Pleasure Costume/Show Hack/Side Saddle Hunter Pleasure Ranch Riding English Trail Western Trail Western Pleasure Halter Mare Halter Gelding/Stallion Sport Horse under Saddle Sr. Sport Horse under Saddle Jr. PB Sport Horse In-Hand Intro Dressage HA Sport Horse In-Hand Training Level Dressage First Level Dressage Second Level/higher Dressage Recreational Riding Intro Western Dressage Western Dressage Walk Trot Pleasure Sport Horse Miscellaneous Walk Trot Equitation Competitive/Endurance Reining Equitation under 19 Equitation over 19

These categories are not limited and more may be added or split.

In addition, the Program will award the following age groups:

10 and under 13 and under Walk Trot Canter

14-18 19-39

40 to 55 over 55 (should you admit it!)

Awards are given out to the participants at the January meeting, currently being held in the DFW Area. The meeting is a banquet showcasing the National Champions and the Regional Champions and features photos of all members shown during the Banquet slide presentation. This year the Banquet will be at the DFW Marriott Hotel on Jan. 27, 2018.

There is a slight cost of \$20.00 per horse and rider combination. This helps to offset the cost of the ribbons and trophies. The competition year runs from Jan 1 to Dec. 31 of each year.

Members need not track their results from Class A shows, or NATRC rides, as the program director does that. Those who attend Open/4-H or other qualifying shows are asked to send in an Open Show Report so those points can be tallied. The Recreational riding form can be sent once a quarter. Both forms, as well as the entry form for the 2018 year will be on the Region 9 Website.
