**Point Calculation:** Same as the qualification points for AHA classes – One point for every horse in the class (including the nominated horse) that the horse/rider places over. For example, if there are 10 horses in the class, and the combination places 3<sup>rd</sup>, they receive 8 points. If there is one horse in the class, then the combination will receive 1 point. Championship (ridden classes) are double points. Halter Championships (including Sport Horse in Hand) will accrue points based on the largest preliminary Halter Class. Reserve Champions in Hand will receive half the points based on the largest preliminary Class.

**Open Show Point Calculation:** One point for every horse in the class (including the nominated horse) that the horse/rider places over multiplied by a factor of .25. For example, if there are 10 horses in the class, and the combination places 3<sup>rd</sup>, they receive 8 x .25 or 2 points. If there is one horse in the class, then the combination will receive 1 point x .25 or .25 points. Championship (ridden classes) are double points times the .25 co-efficient. Halter Championships (including Sport Horse in Hand) will accrue points based on the largest preliminary Halter Class. Reserve Champions in Hand will receive half the points based on the largest preliminary Class times the coefficient.
