## REGION 9 JUNIOR /AMATEUR HI-POINT ENROLLMENT FORM

GENERAL DESCRIPTION: The AHA/Region 9 Amateur/Junior High Point Program will reward its' participants with ribbons, trophies, and kudos at annual awards banquet. The program is open to Arabian and Half-Arabian horses and riders/handlers (competitors), owners as well as Non-Owners who Lease or Borrow their horses. Competitors must reside and compete within the geographical area designated by AHA as Region 9. Points may be earned from activity in OPEN & RATED SHOWS, DRESSAGE, CUTTING, REINING, ENDURANCE, COMPETITIVE TRAIL etc., as well as RECREATIONAL RIDING (hours spent riding the horse in a non-competitive way). Regional and National championship shows are specifically excluded from this program. Participants must hold a current AHA membership card throughout the competitive year.

APPLICATION: Each year, amateur and junior competitors who wish to participate in the program are required to complete an official Entry Form and mail it to the R9/AJHP secretary, along with an annual fee of \$20 per horse/rider combination and copies of their current AHA card and horse registration papers. This is a "One Horse/One Competitor" program. Please use separate entry form for each horse-and-competitor combination. If you have been a prior participant, you do not need to send the horses papers. If you have been a prior participant, you need not send the horses papers if previously sent.

ACTIVITY: A completed official Activity Report form, signed by the Show Secretary or Ride Manager, must be mailed to the R9/AJHP Secretary (it is strongly encouraged, though not required, for this be done within 30 days of each show or ride). For Recreational Riding report of activity must be submitted either monthly or quarterly on the Region 9 Report form or a copy of the AHA Recreational Riding Report Hours Form is acceptable. Points will be calculated using the current R9/AJHP Tables as published by AHA/Region 9. We reserve the right to verify activity reports and placements for accuracy. R9 /AJHP Activity Report forms will be available through R9 communications, or by request from the Program Secretary.

Qualifying events for 2020 awards are those starting with January 1st, 2020 through December 31th, 2020. Winners will be notified of their year-end status and encouraged to attend the R9/AJHP Award Banquet in January. AHA Region 9 reserves the right to modify or cancel this program or any components at any time. Check the R9 Website for a downloadable.pdf rules file, which may be updated from time to time.
