

Updated Schedule Posted to Website

Attention Region 9 Exhibitors:

There has been an updated schedule placed on the Website for your use. Please make sure the schedule you use has the date of 05.06.25 or 05.12.25 for WW in the bottom right corner.

There have been several classes changed and added.

Due to a schedule conflict our WW Judge – Trevor Gerardi-Miller is not able to arrive until Monday Night. The Monday Morning Reining Classes will be rescheduled to Wednesday Morning and English Trail has been moved to Afternoon. There are too many class conflicts in the Afternoon for the Reiners.

After 7 pm on Monday, The trail course will be removed for Reining horses to practice in Watt Arena. Several Obstacles will be setup in the warm up arena for the night.

Concessions & Food on the Grounds:

The Restaurant inside the front corner of the Moncrief barn will be open for business – It is a Taco Heads Franchise, they have a full line of Foods for Lunch & Dinner items. We are also working on having some Food Trucks Available this year that will setup along the roads near John Justin and Moncrief Barns. Caribou Coffee will be open morning thru lunch with coffee, snacks & sandwiches available.

We have asked for Taco Heads to be open Monday – Saturday 11 am – 6 pm each day except Wednesday they will close at 4pm – this is our Exhibitors Bar B Que Dinner from 4-6 pm.

We have asked for Caribou Coffee in the John Justin Building to be open from 7 am -2 pm Monday - Sunday, they will have many Grab N Go options such as sandwiches, salads, wraps, breakfast tacos in the morning, fresh made muffins.

We have asked for the regular concession to also be open in the John Justin Bldg from 12pm to 7 pm. Monday – Friday.

We have asked that the regular concession in the Watt Arena will be open 7:30 am – 4 pm Tuesday – Saturday.

We are also trying to get us some food trucks again this year, the donut truck was a big hit last year, asked about maybe an Ice cream or Smoothies truck in the Afternoons.

Parking & Parking Passes

Just an additional reminder – all Owners receive a free parking pass from the show office They will be good from Monday May 26 – Friday May 30, if you are showing dressage and need extra days, please ask in the show office – we have a few to cover the extra days. When you arrive at the show grounds, prior to the start of the show, you will need to purchase your own pass at \$6/day.

Parking locations will be limited this year with the construction, you can park in the RV Lot -1st row by the Pavillion, Over the Parking Garage (entrance off Harley Dr), behind Moncrief Barn, and beside Cattle Barn 4.

Due to the Graduations that happen every year, I am working on the Details of Trailer Parking for this year, will post something at the show.

The Showers are closed for Construction since they are in the Burnett Building – We have rented a Shower Trailer for exhibitors and Barn Staff to use – it will be placed in the RV Parking Lot Area by the Outdoor Pavillion Arena. It has 4 private shower spaces with Locking Doors for Safety.
