
BREED CLUB MEET INFORMATION

For breed clubs considering placing a meet with the PPBA

From the PPBA Board of Directors and Show Management

Our Intent

The PPBA wants to host your breed club meets in future years and encourages you and your members to consider us as an option. Our 80-year-old organization is recognized as one of the strongest shows in the country, especially in the western United States, and commonly hosts APA and ABA National Meets. Our membership reaches throughout the western states and beyond, and we are noted for strong Junior activities and the quality of birds exhibited by Junior members.

The PPBA show is typically held the last full weekend in January in Lodi, California, approximately 30 minutes south of Sacramento, with cage capacity for upwards of 4,000 holes. We offer a traditional three-day show, progressive hospitality, a Saturday night banquet, Champion Row, and a judge selection process that considers qualified judges from throughout North America 12–24 months in advance.

We believe breed clubs provide tremendous value to the poultry hobby. By following the timelines and guidelines below, we can work together to promote your club, membership, breed, and meet participation.

Timelines & Guidelines

September 30 — Meet Placement Deadline

Inform the PPBA of your desire to hold a meet with us by September 30, or sooner. This is approximately four months ahead of the show. When this deadline is met, PPBA will promote the meet through its website, social media, and printed materials and will submit meet show reports, results, and paperwork to your club within four weeks after the show. Requests received after this deadline may still be hosted, but the breed club or its members will be responsible for submitting show reports and results.

October 15 — Premium Book Deadline

Provide all meet information, specials, and boilerplates/logos to PPBA Show Management for inclusion in the premium book by October 15.

Regional & National Meets — Plan One Season Ahead

PPBA welcomes Regional and National meets and strongly encourages clubs to place these meets with us during the prior show season. Advance placement gives breeders a full breeding season to prepare and hatch for the meet, builds interest within the breed club, supports stronger entries and quality, and gives PPBA additional time to celebrate and advertise the breed and meet.

Judge Selection & Financial Specials

For Regional or National meets, PPBA will provide a list of judges hired for that show year for the breed club to select from. The club's selection should be provided to PPBA Show Management by January 1 for the show scheduled later that month. PPBA does not directly fund financial specials; however, we will assist exhibitors and members in coordinating donated funds, establishing a goal, and communicating internally to help support the meet.
