## Masonic Education

One of the most important of all our Landmarks is that which forbids us to participate in lodge, as Masons, in any form of religious or political sectarianism. We cannot question a candidate as to his peculiar beliefs in religion or politics; we cannot discuss such matters in any of our assemblies, and we cannot take any kind of public action with regard to them in the name of the Craft. A candidate must pledge himself to a belief in God and to a belief in Immortality, and he must reverence the Volume of Sacred Law as a rule and guide for his life. The Doctrinal interpretation he may place on these beliefs must, however, be left entirely to him. So also he must pledge himself to good citizenship, but his choice of a political party through which he works for the realization of his ideal of citizenship must be left entirely to him.
