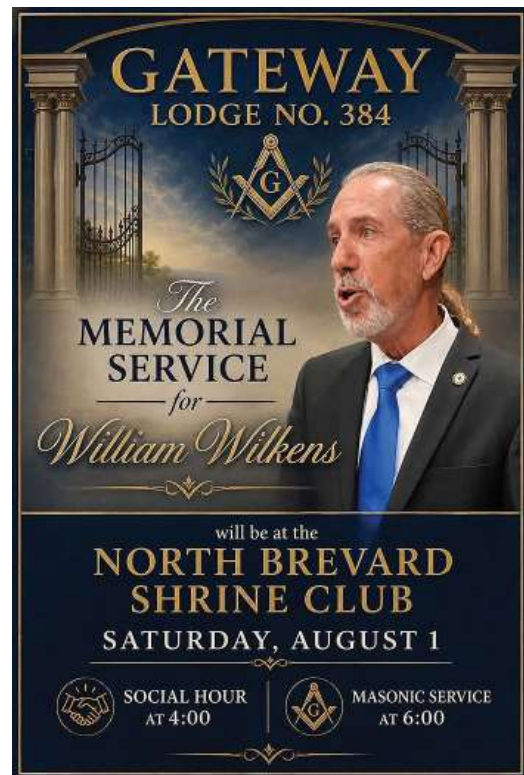
Brothers, please come assist on the Kids Fishing Event at Loughman Lake.

Allied Masonic Degrees

The Allied Masonic Degrees is a prestigious organization that operates as an appendent body of Freemasonry. It is dedicated to the study, preservation and practice of a collection of lesser-known Masonic degrees. Membership in the AMD is by invitation only and requires individuals to be Royal Arch Masons in good standing. The AMD places a strong emphasis on Masonic education, providing resources and opportunities for members to engage in research, study and discussion. This commitment to education helps deepen members' understanding of Masonic principles and their historical contexts.

The AMD administers several degrees, each offering unique insights into Masonic history and philosophy. Some of the notable degrees include:

1. St. Lawrence the Martyr: Emphasizes charity and self-sacrifice.
2. Knights of Constantinople: Explores themes of humility and reconciliation.
3. Grand Tilers of Solomon: Highlights the role of the Tiler in Freemasonry.
4. Order of the Secret Monitor: Centers on friendship and brotherhood.
