Masonic Education

The 47th Problem of Euclid, better known in geometry as the Pythagorean Theorem, states that in a right-angled triangle, the sum of the areas of the two smaller squares on the legs equals the area of the largest square on the hypotenuse.

In Freemasonry, this 3:4:5 triangle is far more than a mathematical truth—it is a symbol of moral and intellectual balance. The square represents virtue, the compasses represent spiritual boundaries, and together they frame the idea that knowledge, when applied with precision, leads to harmony. For Master Masons, the 47th Problem is a reminder that just as the sides of the triangle are perfectly proportioned, so too should a Mason strive for proportion in thought, action and character, uniting the practical sciences with the deeper mysteries of moral law.
