



The Spring Hill Education Foundation (SHEF) is celebrating its most impactful years to date, driven by strong community support, record-breaking events, and a continued commitment to enhancing opportunities for students and educators across USD 230.

This spring marked a major milestone as SHEF hosted its 30th Annual Golf Tournament on April 27th at Prairie Highlands Golf Club. The event proved to be a tremendous success, continuing a legacy that has now raised nearly \$400,000 since its inception. With strong participation and community enthusiasm, the tournament once again highlighted the power of local support in action.

In March, the 2nd Annual SHEF Gala set a new standard, doubling its inaugural success. With close to 250 attendees, the event raised more than \$37,000, bringing together supporters for an evening of celebration, connection, and purpose. "To see nearly 250 people come together and more than double our impact shows how deeply Spring Hill believes in supporting our students," said Brittany Stewart, SHEF Board President and Gala Chair.

The success of these events has led directly to expanded opportunities for students. In 2026, SHEF increased its scholarship program from 15 to 20 graduating seniors, awarding \$40,000 in scholarships, the largest amount in the Foundation's history.

Beyond scholarships, SHEF continues to make significant investments in classroom innovation and student support. A major focus has been the expansion of Project Lead the Way (PLTW) curriculum. Phase II of this three-phase initiative received a major boost through a grant for \$27,300 from SEATS Inc. (W.R. and Floy A. Sauey Family Foundation) and \$29,400 from the First Option Bank Trust Foundation. "The support behind Project Lead the Way has been transformational for our district," according to SHEF Executive Director BJ Harris. "These investments are not just funding curriculum—they're opening doors for students to explore STEM pathways and preparing them for the careers of tomorrow."

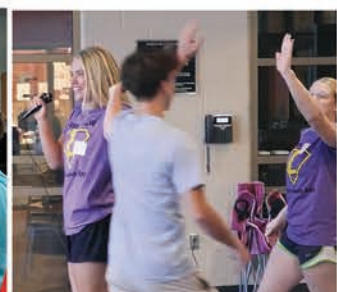
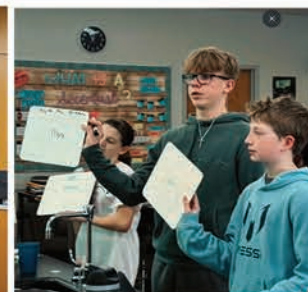
Additional initiatives throughout the year



have further strengthened educational experiences. SHEF supported the Parade of Playhouses Project in partnership with Crown Realty and DLR Group, provided funding for the Choir's Masterworks Concert, and supplied LEGO League competition kits to support student innovation and teamwork.

All told, by the end of this school year, the Spring Hill Education Foundation will have contributed more than \$100,000 in support of USD 230 schools. With growing community engagement and continued success across its events and initiatives, SHEF remains dedicated to its mission of creating excellence in the classroom and beyond.
