## Homicide detective charged with fraud

Deputies: Sgt. illegally obtained painkillers

SARASOTA - Authorities have arrested a Sarasota homicide detective for lying to doctors and illegally obtaining prescription painkillers.

Sgt. Chris Hallisey, a lead investigator in the murder of Carlie Brucia, was charged with fraud for concealing information to obtain prescriptions, the Sarasota County Sheriff's Office said. He was released on \$360 bond Monday morning.

According to deputies, Hallisey had been under investigation by his own supervisors for several weeks as the Sheriff's Office contacted doctors who were believed to have provided Hallisey with oxycodone.

Deputies say Hallisey was placed on administrative leave last week. He was hired by the Sheriff's Office in 1990.
