Murray B. Cohen

Dear Steve:

On 12/3/15, I received a telephone call from an Assistant United States Attorney, Stephen Muldrow, informing me that the United States Attorney's Office would not be acting on the information packet about the apparent cover-up of your father's murder, which packet had been delivered to the U.S. Attorney's office on 7/2/14, after an earlier information packet, identical to the one received, had curiously been lost or misplaced.

Mr. Muldrow's legal explanation for inaction appeared cursory and incomplete. He indicated the federal government's general lack of jurisdiction of the crime of murder, while not commenting on the presentation of altered evidence by the Sarasota County Sheriff's Department to the F.B.I Lab in Quantico, Virginia, for review and analysis by the F.B.I. in 2004. He seemed to conclude that since the F.B.I. had received the 911 call from the Sarasota County Sheriff's Department in 2004, any requested federal involvement is now time barred by a five (5) year Statute of Limitations. I did not follow the five (5) year analysis because your father's estate has been closed for less than five (5) years, and I had asked Mr. Muldrow about the availability of "Big Brother" for justice when a local jurisdiction has engaged in a systemic and monolithic cover-up of a murder. His comments indicated that he was aware of "players" in the cover-up because he mentioned Detective Halisey, and the "individual" who had an affair with Maria Cohen. He curiously asked me, in so many words, "who would be the players, the Judges?"


I shared with him my representation of you in the contested probate proceedings, that a pattern of Court decisions adverse to your position had developed, and that I had informed you of my belief that the many outcomes in the probate proceedings adverse to your interest had been "preordained." I reiterated the existence of the Corazol at your father's house, a poison that is banned in the United States but is available in Bolivia, where your father "married" Maria Amurrio. I also informed Mr. Muldrow that two (2) judges separately denied our request to exhume your father's body, and that Ms. Amurrio had not permitted an autopsy. I shared with Mr. Muldrow my observation that the Court did not appear to be concerned or interested in any false testimony given by Ms. Cohen (Amurrio) at anytime.

I shared with Mr. Muldrow our knowledge that Ms. Cohen's name appeared in a type of federal registry suggesting that she had some kind of federal protection. I expressed frustration and alarm to Mr. Muldrow that such an individual could be allowed to murder without accountability.

It became apparent that at the conclusion of our telephone conference, which lasted about thirty (30) to thirty-five (35) minutes, that Mr. Muldrow was ready to terminate the conversation.
