Steve,

I responded to Mark last week on this issue wherein I told him I did initially think that have the FBI review a new version of the call would be helpful. However (read my report on this section), after interviewing the Unit Chief who was responsible for the original FBI review, it was obvious to me they were not as interested in re-addressing this case as perhaps you were led to believe. In fact they directed me to the Office of General Counsel for any further follow-up. Also, as I described in the report, after listening to the call more than 100 times, and interviewing the three experts who were involved in the investigation early on, it became obvious to me that the evidence in this case is the original call itself, and any expert's analysis is just that, the expert's analysis. I pointed out that should this case ever go to court, the judge would instruct the jury that what "they" hear on the tape is what is the evidence, not what any expert says they heard. I noted that I heard the call much different than you did, and did not hear everything you heard or what your experts heard. But I did hear something, and I heard more than the SSO or FDLE said they heard. So it is an extremely subjective area of the case.

Concerning the CD, I gave all of the paperwork, reports, photos, and notes that I used to Mark. Some of it is in the form of six binders I created of back-up data (tabs), but anything that was not tabbed was also given to Mark. The only thing I have retained is an electronic file which mostly consists of documents you emailed to me.

I am hoping for the best when Mark gives this to the State Attorney.
