

- 1. After your tattoo practitioner places the clear bandage on your new tattoo, It should be left on for the amount of time that was recommended by your artist (usually about 4 to 5 days)
- 2. When removing the bandage, it is recommended to do it while in the shower under warm water to loosen the adhesive.
- **3.** Gently pull the bandage over itself in the direction of the hair growth. Avoid pulling upward.
- 4. After bandage is removed, wash the area with neutral soap and warm water then pat dry with a clean paper towel.
- 5. Use the recommended lotion to keep it moisturized for the rest of the healing process.
 - It is normal for blood and fluids to collect under the bandage.
 - For best results replace the first bandage after 8 24 hours
 - The bandage should not be worn for longer than 7 days.
