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Program Name	Description
Academics	Students will be challenged with academic work on Math, Reading Comprehension, Social Studies, Science, Analogy and Logic Thinking based on their grade and individual level. Math works will include math drills and also focus more on word problems. They will review what they've learned in the past school year and learn something new to help kick off the coming school year.
Art	Art classes include drawing, sketching, and painting with different medium by professional art instructors. Students will develop their creativity and drawing/painting skills through carefully designed lessons.
Crafts	Students will learn to make crafts with different materials. It will be hands-on fun activities to build creativity and imagination of kids.
STEM Challenge with LEGO®	Refine your construction skills as you tinker with Play-Well TEKnologies and tens of thousands of LEGO® parts!
