



Dual 360° Deck Products Limited Warranty

Eco Deck Canada Ltd ("Eco Deck")

Section 1: Warranty Coverage

Eco Deck Canada Ltd ("Eco Deck") warrants to the original purchaser and any permitted transferee under Section 6 that, for twenty-five (25) years from the date of original purchase for residential applications and ten (10) years from the date of original purchase for commercial applications, the following warranty applies.

Please read this product warranty carefully.

All customers must comply with the correct installation and maintenance procedures.

Pay close attention to Registration, Warranty Claim Process, Exclusions, Colour & Stain Limitations.

- Warranty registration must be initiated within 45 days of purchase to be eligible for coverage under this limited warranty.
 - Register by emailing sales@ecodeckcanada.com and providing your full name and order reference number.
 - You may initiate registration before the decking installation is complete.
 - After installation, provide at least three clear photographs of the completed deck taken from different angles. These photographs must be provided before any warranty claim can be assessed.
 - Installation must comply with the expansion gaps, drainage slope, joist centres, and other requirements outlined in the Eco Deck Installation Guide.
 - Damage resulting from failure to follow the Eco Deck Installation Guide is not covered, as described in Section 7.
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Section 3: Product Warranty

We warrant that, under normal use and service conditions, Eco Deck Dual 360° products are free from material defects in workmanship and materials and will not split, splinter, rot, or suffer structural damage from termites or fungal decay.

If a defect is discovered within the warranty period, notify Eco Deck™ in writing at sales@ecodeckcanada.com.

Section 4: Warranty Claim Process

- Eco Deck Canada Ltd may request additional information regarding a warranty claim.
- Upon validation by an authorized Eco Deck™ representative, Eco Deck Canada Ltd will, at its discretion, either replace the defective item or refund the portion of the purchase price paid (excluding installation or delivery costs).
- The remedies described are the sole and exclusive remedy for breach of any warranty.
- Under no circumstances shall Eco Deck™ be liable for amounts exceeding the replacement value of the defective product.

Liability Limitations

- To the maximum extent permitted by applicable law, Eco Deck Canada Ltd will not be liable for indirect, incidental, special, consequential, or economic losses arising from the purchase, installation, use, removal, or inability to use Dual 360° products. This includes loss of use, lost revenue or profits, business interruption, and removal or reinstallation costs.
 - Eco Deck Canada Ltd's total liability under this limited warranty will not exceed the remedy available under Section 4 and the applicable prorated recovery amount set out in Section 5.
 - Nothing in this warranty limits or excludes any liability or consumer right that cannot lawfully be limited or excluded under applicable provincial or federal law.
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Application Definitions

- Residential application: Installation of Dual 360° product on an individual residence
 - Commercial application: Any installation other than on an individual residence
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Section 5: Prorated Recovery Table

Section 6: Warranty Transfer

- Residential: Transferable one (1) time within three (3) years of original purchase to a subsequent buyer of the property.
- Commercial: Freely transferable to subsequent buyers of the property.

Section 7: Exclusions

Eco Deck™ does not provide warranty coverage for failures, malfunctions, or damage caused by:

- Incorrect installation or failure to comply with the Eco Deck Installation & Maintenance Guide.
- Improper gapping, including failure to maintain 5 mm (approximately 3/16 in) side-to-side spacing, a minimum 6 mm (approximately 1/4 in) at end-to-end butt joints, and a minimum 10 mm (approximately 3/8 in) clearance from walls, posts, and other fixed objects.
- Insufficient drainage (slope 3–6 mm every 30 cm away from the house; water pooling).
- Failure to use Eco Deck™ equipment (clips, fasteners, screws, approved accessories).
- Use beyond normal conditions or in unapproved applications.
- Ground or structural movement, distortion, or collapse.
- Acts of God (e.g., flood, hurricane, earthquake, lightning).
- Environmental conditions (e.g., air pollution, mould, mildew, polluted water).
- Staining from foreign substances (bleach, hazardous materials, non-household oil, urine, etc.).
- Normal weathering (UV, sunlight, heat, fading, chalk, dirt, spots, stains).
- Colour variations or changes in Dual 360° products.
- Improper handling, storage, cleaning, maintenance, abuse, or neglect.
- Products not paid in full.
- Ordinary wear and tear.

Joist Spacing:

- Residential: 12-inch recommended (max 16")
 - Commercial: 10-inch recommended (max 12")
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Section 8: Colour Limitation

No composite decking is fade-proof.

Weathering is expected over the product's life and is not covered under warranty.

Weathering includes fading, chalking, lightening, dirt, or stains from exposure to natural elements.

Section 9: Stain Limitations

- Dual 360° products are stain-resistant but not stain-proof.
 - Stains from food and beverages (ketchup, mustard, oils, tea, wine, coffee, grease, soft drinks, beer) must be cleaned within 24 hours with hot, soapy water (not boiling).
 - Mould and mildew may settle if not cleaned regularly (monthly cleaning recommended).
 - Not covered: Stains from bleach, acid, paints, plant food, household oils, rust, chemicals, strong solvents, and improper cleaning products.
 - Warranty void if not regularly cleaned and maintained.
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Section 10: Additional Terms

- Eco Deck authorizes no one to make additional warranties.
 - This warranty may only be altered with the written authorization of Eco Deck Canada Ltd.
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Section 11: Warp, Crack & Splinter Resistance Limitations

Dual 360° products resist warping, cracking, and splintering but may experience such issues if installed incorrectly, especially with poor drainage or insufficient expansion gaps.

- Cracks may appear if exposed to prolonged standing water or pooling caused by inadequate drainage.
 - Maintain proper expansion gaps and drainage.
 - For raised decks: allow good airflow and drainage; water should drain easily.
 - Always ensure proper deck drainage during installation.
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Section 12: Low Maintenance

- Clean monthly with hot, soapy water, a soft-bristle brush, or a power washer (max. 1500 psi).
- Spray in the direction of the board grain using a fan tip nozzle (minimum 6 inches from the surface).
- Use appropriate cleaning products only.

- Increase cleaning in spring and autumn to remove dirt and debris.
