

Saying Goodbye With Dignity

There are few moments as hard to deal with as losing part of the family. This doesn't necessarily mean people family,

because euthanizing your dog or your

cat, your best friend, is just as hard because they too are family. What I have found with the dogs that I've had to euthanize, and there have been quite a few, there are different ways and veterinarians that think differently than the others, so nothing is engraved in stone. To make the matters worse, for some reason, veterinarians have decided that in order to put your pet to sleep you need to cough up somewhere between \$250 and \$400.

For the everyday person out there, we don't normally keep that much money in our wallet for things such as this. We have rent to pay, groceries to buy, kids' clothes to buy etc. etc. So we find people who take it on themselves to shoot their dog, or have someone do it for them. I really have a problem with that. But then I'm not exactly happy with the way some of the veterinarians do it either.

For instance, the higher priced vet doctors want to give your animal an examination to make sure that it's as sick as you think it is. And of course, since they're doing this major exam, blood work etcetera, the bill just keeps going up. Then you have the other veterinarians that say fine, you bring them in, they lay them on a table, they give your pet a shot that relaxes him, and he goes to sleep. Then they give him a shot that takes care of his life. This is definitely a humane way to do it. The dogs just go to sleep and they don't know what's going on.

Then you have the veterinarians that will say, well let's do this easy and I'll only charge you X amount of dollars, not very much, and of course that's attractive because if you can save a dollar you're better off, right? So they take your pet in and the first thing they do is they put a line in their vein. OK, I don't like that done to me it hurts and so I know it hurts the dog, so this is intravenous.



What now happens is they have some medication they push into the line, the medication hits the heart, burns it so fast and so bad that the dog is gone. I don't

agree with this and this is the very worst way. I almost would rather cut their throat and let them bleed to death than do this. My reason is they're wide awake and they can feel pain build.

I had a dog who was having a lot of trouble breathing. She was a dog I had found half starved and had taken care of her. I thought she was getting along fine. So one day all of a sudden for no reason she starts gasping for breath and I was out of town so I went to the local vet, and they checked her

out. The diagnosis was she had a growth in her lungs and it was going to kill her. So of course I said, well let's put her down now instead of letting her suffer. Seemed like the right thing to do at the time. The first thing I noticed they put a intravenous line into her leg. I had never seen that done before so I didn't know what was going to go on. I'm standing there waiting to see what's going to happen next and they come in there and they give her a shot now this dog trusted me 100% and as the fluid started to hit her heart she looked at me with fear and horror in her face. No, it did not last very long it was pretty quick, but it wasn't fast enough for her not to feel the pain and then she was gone and I cried. And I was not crying

for the dog herself because like I said, she was a stray. What I was crying about was the fact that she had been through so much and she had to go through that terrible pain to end her life.

So there are choices and different vets who think about euthanasia differently. I suggest that you talk to that doctor to find out what they do before you get caught torturing that dog or cat just as he is dying. There are vets that are not as high-priced as others so it would also benefit you to find out the different costs for different doctors

Also I was told that there is something that you can buy off the Internet that will euthanize your dog painlessly. I'm not recommending this, but it is worth checking out. If it is painless, it

would be something to look into if you're low on money and you've got a terminally ill pet. There is a lot of checking before you take that big step.
