Bluegrass Fish Keepers Association BOWL SHOW RULES

- 1. Everyone entering the bowl show must be a BFKA member and be present at the meeting. Non-members who wish to show may join the club and enter the show on the same day.
- 2. Entries must be registered with the Bowl Show Committee and set up before judging begins.
- 3. Fish categories for each show will be announced in advance and posted publicly. Unqualified entries will be removed by the Bowl Show Committee.
- There is a limit of two entries per member, per category each month. Entry fee is \$2 per fish.
- 5. Fish can be entered in a flat-sided container up to 5 gallons in size. Larger tanks must have their own stands. Goldfish may be shown in tanks or tubs. No decorations, gravel, or backing are allowed, but a small sprig of a plant is okay. An airstone may be placed in the container. Only one entry per tank, unless a divider is provided. The Bluegrass Fish Keepers Association has a limited number of small "show" tanks for rent if requested.
- 6. Entries will be removed at the request of the Bowl Show Committee if there is any sign of stress or disease.
- 7. Judging for the best fish overall will be performed by a judge or judges selected by the Bowl Show Judging Committee. Ribbons will be awarded for 1st-3rd place, and points will be awarded toward year-end awards. Points will be awarded as follows:
 - a. First place 5 points
 - b. Second Place 4 points
 - c. Third Place 3 points
 - d. Per Entrant: 1 point for participation for non-placing entry
- 8. A People's Choice award will be chosen at each show, which will be judged by secret ballot of all BFKA members present at the meeting. Each member may cast only one vote.
- 9. The member(s) with the highest points in a year will receive an award for "Showperson of the Year".
- 10. The officers of the Bluegrass Fish Keepers Association and the members of the Bowl Show Committee will not be responsible for any losses.
- 11. The Bowl Show Committee is the final authority on all matters.
