## BASIC SUPPLIES

- ☒ Gauze rolls & pads (for wrapping wounds or muzzling)
  - ☒ Adhesive tape (pet-safe)
  - ☒ Non-stick bandages or self-cling wrap
  - ☒ Antiseptic wipes/spray (pet-safe only!)
  - ☒ Tweezers (for splinters, ticks)
  - ☒ Blunt-tip scissors
  - ☒ Digital thermometer (rectal use only for pets)
  - ☒ Lubricant (for thermometer – water-based)
  - ☒ Disposable gloves
  - ☒ Cotton balls or swabs
  - ☒ Towels or clean cloths

## MEDICAL ESSENTIALS

- ☒ Hydrogen peroxide (3%) – *only use to induce vomiting under vet instruction*
- ☒ Saline solution (for eye or wound flushing)
- ☒ Styptic powder or cornstarch (to stop minor bleeding)
- ☒ Antihistamine (e.g., Benadryl – dosage from your vet)



- ☒ Activated charcoal (only under vet advice)
  - ☒ Any pet-specific medications your animal needs

### SAFETY & COMFORT

- ☒ Soft muzzle (even gentle pets may bite when hurt)
  - ☒ Leash or slip lead
  - ☒ Pet carrier or blanket for transport
  - ☒ Flashlight or headlamp
  - ☒ Collapsible food/water bowl
  - ☒ Extra bottled water & sealed food portion
