It has been my pleasure to attend school events and activities with our students, including school Masses, liturgies, Virtue Assemblies, chess tournaments, math events, guest speakers, arts events, sports tournaments and Eco initiatives to name a few. I am proud to be a part of our Dufferin-Peel Catholic District School Board (DPCDSB).

- **Graduates:** Congratulations to all of our DPCDSB graduating students! As you continue your journey of life-long learning may the foundation of our Catholic faith uphold and guide you. I look forward to attending the upcoming graduation ceremonies for our Grade 8 and Grade 12 students this month, in Wards 9 and 10.
- **Update:** DPCDSB continues to work through the detailed GSN (Grants for Student Needs) calculations. Although released late in the year, the GSN is similar to the original March 15 announcement made by the Minister of Education. At this time, we estimate a preliminary reduction on a year-over-year basis, of over \$15 million. This reduction reflects the impact of changes in class size, elimination of Local Priority Funding (LPF) and other grant reductions. Position reductions that have been enacted as part of the staffing procedures for 2019-2020 have been accomplished by attrition and transfer, with no layoffs.

We are reviewing all feedback from our public consultation process, as well as all program and service areas. Identifying expenditure reductions and efficiencies that would be required is a priority for our Board to propose a balanced budget. A report on public consultation will be presented at the upcoming June 4th - Administration and Finance Committee meeting. Any further information updates and consultations we receive from the Ministry will be shared with school communities in a timely manner.
