PLEASE NOTE: Health & Show Requirements - Current Coggins, Flu & Rhino vaccines on every horse & Health Certificate (30 Day) for Out of State horses to be presented at the show office.

Pre-entry consists of: Completed Entry Form per horse - front and back (typed signatures are acceptable on entry form. Forms must have correct horse registration number and PFHA member numbers. Also, horse registrations and PFHA membership cards for every owner, trainer, rider and handler are required.

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of license competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent (s), legal guardian(s) or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parents, guardians and/or trainers who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parents, guardians and/or trainers from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

- **ARENAS.** All arenas are closed nightly at 8:00pm. These arenas will open again at 6:00am each event day. Any alterations to this schedule will must be made no less than 2 weeks in advance of your event. Additional fees will apply
- **LUNGING.** Lunging is permitted in designated areas only. Lunging is prohibited on GGT Fiber and in competition arenas.
- **FLIERS** of any kind are not to be hung without approval of NEC management. Those not approved with be taken down.
- **EARLY ARRIVALS.** Early arriving exhibitors must notify the facility of their intention to move-in no less than 5 days prior to the event's move in day. Early arrival fees will apply for each stall occupied by human, animal, tack, equipment, feed/hay or other property. Early arrival fees do not include access/use of NEC arenas
- **STALLS.** NEC does not permit the use of nails, staple-gun staples, screws, hooks or other devices to be driven into any portion of stall walls or building walls. When erecting or installing equipment, Exhibitors must use temporary materials, such as zip-ties, Velcro, masking tape, etc., that do not cause permanent damage to NEC property.
- **BEDDING.** All stall bedding must be provided by NEC. Exhibitors using outside bedding will be responsible for a \$100 fee for violation per stall. Bedding ordered after 3:00p may be delivered the following day. ** Payment may be required to secure delivery of advance bedding orders.*
- **HORSES.** Each horse must have an assigned stall. No tie-outs are permitted. Do not tether horses to stall doors, arena railings or other fencing/property that can be damaged by spooked animals.
- **DOGS.** Dogs on leashes are welcome at NEC. Please be sure leashed dogs are connected to a responsible person at all times.
- **RV PAD ACCESS & RERVATIONS.** R.V. pads must be reserved no less than five (5) days ahead of arrival by going to: [St. Charles County Parks - Rental Search](#) . Pad locations are assigned and unlocked only when payment has been secured by a credit card. R.V.s/LQ Trailers will not be able to hook-up to electric and water when no reservation or secured form of payment is made in advance. The NEC Services office closes at 4:30p daily. Overnight staff will not be able to unlock sites.
- **PARKING.** Park in designated parking only. Do not park trailers on RV Pads unless hooking up to an electric service. Do not park any vehicles in fire lanes, in front of manure pits or in front of barn doors. Do not block driveways. Citations may be issued by police and vehicles towed at owner's expense. Electric vehicles may not use any outlets to charge. NO RVs are to by parked outside of RV area
- **FIRE CODES.** NEC is a non-smoking facility by County/City Ordinance. For fire safety, NEC also prohibits in its barns, stalls and tents the following: 2-prong appliances, 2-prong extension cords, light duty indoor extension cords, 3-way adaptors. Fans connected by 3-prong heavy-duty outdoor extension cords are okay. Any items plugged in should be UL rated.
