SEASONAL RULES QUICK REFERENCE GUIDE

These rules are in random order _ keep in mind these rules are fluid and may be modified at any time. The most current copy will be kept on file at the campground office and available upon request. Campers ensure adults, teens, children of your campsite and visitors understand these rules. We reserve the right to restrict children to their site if their behavior or actions are unacceptable.

Campground activities as referenced in camper documents such as liability waiver, random rules, etc. include but are not limited to Swimming Pond, Mini Golf, Jumping Pillow, Shower House, Basketball, Volleyball, Beach Area, Playground, Glow Parade, Hayride and General Weekend Activities.

- 1. Alcohol can be enjoyed responsibly _ **if intoxicated** you are not allowed to participate in campground activities or operate any mode of transportation. Alcohol use is **not tolerated** by underage campers.
- 2. Persons 18 years or older are permitted to smoke outdoors in common areas. Underage smokers will not be tolerated (this includes e-cigarettes/vaping) and will be asked to return to their site.
- 3. Speed Limit within the campground for any type of transportation is **5 mph**.
- 4. ATV/UTV's are allowed from your campsite directly to 11th road and back _ never all around the campground.
- 5. The campground can **only accept** electric battery charged golf carts. Carts must clearly display a CRC golf cart license and must be insured. Licensed drivers may drive golfs carts and all **are to be listed** on your cart agreement. Exception is teens with a learner's permit copy **filed at the office** and driving with parents.
- 6. Littering is **prohibited** within the campground _ sufficient trash receptacles are available. This includes pet waste always make sure to pick up, bag and toss to keep our campground clean.
- 7. The Dog Park is available **only until** DARK or 9:00PM whichever comes first.
- 8. The campground property where the dog park resides along the river and near the leave/twigs dump area is **off limits after** DARK or 9:00PM whichever comes first.
- 9. Electric usage invoices are processed in April, June, August and October and are **to be paid promptly** so be diligent in paying your bills on time. Late fees will be charged for past due status. We do our best but we cannot guarantee that all utilities are operational at all times. CRC is **not responsible** for any loss during outages.
- 10. Respectful language is expected in all public areas including your campsite. Bullying will not be tolerated.
- 11. No one under the age of 18 may **be left unsupervised** on the property other than for a short period of time. overnight stay **is not acceptable**. Parent or legal guardians are responsible for the whereabouts, actions, and safety of their child(ren) while at campground.
- 12. After 10:00PM children under 18 years of age must be at a campsite and under supervision.
- 13. Quiet hours are 10:30PM-7:30AM. After 10:30PM **be extremely quiet** where voices/music/games cannot be heard by anyone beyond your campsite.
- 14. Fireworks are prohibited in campground and the only exception is sparklers or poppers.
- 15. **Pets must be on a secure leash** at all times within the campground. Please do not leave unattended pets should you leave your site or campground_ best they be put into your camper when you are not present.

- 16. Sewer pump outs to be reserved at the store <u>no later than Sunday Noon</u>. Should you require an emergency pump out during peak hours contact the staff for consideration. Be conscious to check your tank regularly.

 Messages by text/phone/email will not be accepted. Sign up and pay in the store before services rendered.
- 17. Trees/bushes on your campsite **are the property of the campground**. No trees or bushes dead or alive shall be cut **without prior permission** from the owner. Always do your best **to not cause harm** to our green space.

18. Jumping Pillow:

- Rules of the jumping pillow are posted at the pillow
- No one is allowed to wear shoes/boots on the pillow socks & bare feet only
- No pushing, shoving, flips, somersaults or gymnastics allowed on the jumping pillow
- The jumping pillow is not a "hang out" location for teens or adults no stationary sitting
- Nothing but jumpers are allowed on the pillow _ no phones, toys, bikes, sharp objects, food or drink
- The jumping pillow is off limits when wet from morning/evening dew or following a rain shower
- No one is allowed on the jumping pillow with wet swimwear or wet feet _ must dry off first
- If mixed ages are on the pillow be mindful of little jumpers who might be tossed and hurt
- No one is allowed on the jumping pillow for any reason when it is not inflated
- Do not play on or damage in any way the fencing around the pillow
- Any staff member or adult has the right to remind you of these rules

19. Swimming Pond & Sand Area:

- Rules of pond use are posted
- You swim at your own risk NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY
- Keep the pond and sand areas clean _ dispose of your litter and cigarette butts in receptacles
- The campground owned lawn chairs are not to be placed in the water at any time
- Do not keep any of your chairs, inflatables, toys or canopies on the sand or in the water overnight
- Any child under the age of 14 must be accompanied by an adult while in the pond/beach area
 - o Parents are not to leave their child(ren) unattended even though other adults are present
- Life vests are required for any non-experienced swimmers
- Diving is never allowed anywhere in the pond
- No swimming under any of the pond inflatables
- Do not unfasten or move any of the pond inflatables or their tether ropes/weights
- Do not throw debris of any kind in the water
- Pond Waterslide:
 - O No jumping off the top or sides of the slide inflatable
 - No sitting, hanging out or sun tanning on the slide or any of the inflatables
 - o No swim tubes, rings or noodles to be used down the slide or on any of the inflatables
- Please respect the area of campsite A35 on the pond edge as you would want for your own campsite
- The volleyball area is to be clear of chairs or bikes to not prohibit play never pull or hang on net
- Any staff member or adult has the right to remind you of these rules

20. Basketball Court Rules:

- When anyone is on the court playing basketball no one should stand or sit in the way to prevent play
- Basketballs are available to check out in the store or you may use own
- Any staff member or adult has the right to remind you of these rules

21. Shower House:

- Shower house hours are 7:30AM 10:00PM
- Use the external spray hose to wash off your sandy feet before entering the shower house
- There is to be no warming up from swimming in the showers
- Smoking is never allowed in or at the shower house

- Be aware motion detection lights might turn off while showering _ shower temps are not adjustable
- Wipes of any kind nor anything other than standard toilet paper are allowed to be flushed in toilets
- The shower house is a camping community benefit so please treat this amenity with respect
- Any staff member or adult has the right to remind you of these rules

22. Playground:

- You may only be on the swings if you wish to swing _ do not just sit on them when kids are present
- Do not throw the swings over the frame or toss around unoccupied swings
- Only children up to the age of 4 are allowed to use the toddler swings
- Small children are usually around the swings area so be careful of them at all times
- The cabin playhouse if for children 10 and under never climb on the roof or in/out of the windows
- Take care of and be careful on all playground equipment
- Make sure to dispose of all garbage in the trash cans _ do not litter
- Any staff member or adult has the right to remind you of these rules

23. Mini-Golf Course:

- The course is only open during daylight hours
- You may check out putters and balls from the store or you may use your own
- When checking out putters and balls be sure to have your wrist band on to do so
- Always putt the balls never drive them and keep the golf balls on the course
- Any lawn art or statues along the course are for decoration_ do not touch or move them
- Any staff member or adult has the right to remind you of these rules

24. Bicycle, Hoverboard and Power Wheels (BHP) Rules:

- Moving vehicles within the campground must be conscious and courteous of these riders
- BHP riders are to be on the lookout for other riders, any moving vehicles and people walking
- Always be careful at campground road intersections, on curves and hills
- BHP's are to follow the 5mph campground speed limit
- BHP's riders must have lights on after dark
- BHP's are not allowed under the pavilion, on the patio, basketball court or mini-golf course
- Use the bike racks at the store and pavilion if you don't have a kickstand _ always keep bikes upright
- Any power wheel with the rider lower than a normal bike seat must have an alert flag attached
- Never cut in front of or ride along side or behind any type of motor vehicle
- BHP's are only allowed on campground roads _ do not ever cut through people's campsites
- During a glow ride BHP's and are only allowed at the very end behind all golf carts
- Any staff member or adult has the right to remind you of these rules

25. Fishing Cleaning Station:

- Always double bag your fish guts and place bag in the freezer
- Make sure to tidy up and turn off water and lights off when finished
- 26. Glow Ride will be held **when weather is acceptable**. All the go must glow! Wagon riders will get on at the store patio and must stay on till the ride is complete.
- 27. Poison control is restricted outside of your camper; the only exception is within an enclosed campsite shed.
- 28. There is no burning of leaves allowed at your campsites so take your gathered leaves to the disposal area.
- 29. Leaves, grass clippings, fallen twigs/branches are not to be placed on the road but rather disposed of at the marked area across from the dog park.
- 30. Firewood is available for sale from the campground. You are allowed to bring in your own firewood as long as it's not ash or oak and must be from within Marquette County to prevent tree disease transfer per DNR ruling.

- 31. LP tanks can be filled at the campground. Bring your empty tanks >100# to the patio and leave in the designated area. Be sure your last name and campsite number are on the tank with permanent marker. The filled tanks will be returned to your site **but will not be hooked up** to your camper.
- 32. There are restrictions to be considered when wanting a yard shed, deck or awning. Get approval by campground owners prior to purchase and/or construction. Marquette County permits may be required.
- 33. The island metal refuse area **is off limits** and only for campground owners, staff or by special permission approval. No one should be in this area to dump or remove anything **without prior approval**.
- 34. Dumpsters are provided and the **camper is required to take** their household garbage to that area. All garbage is to be in sealed bags and cardboard boxes are to be flattened before placing in dumpster. Building materials, appliances, furniture, batteries, paint, electronics, etc. **are prohibited and you are required to take these home for disposal**. If you question if an item is acceptable in the dumpster, check first with campground staff. Note dumpsters are only available to campers from April 15 October 15 any other times are off limits.
- 35. Your campsite number **must remain displayed near the road**. If you didn't receive your new campsite number plaque, please let the office know. The new signs are to be displayed and old ones to be disposed of. If you need a new or replacement pole or any assistance, just ask.
- 36. If you can't find your Guest/Wristband Cards for your site visitors; see the office for replacements (\$).
- 37. **It is your responsibility to have your visitors check in/out at the office** to update your campsite attendance and for the campground staff to be aware of visitors should an emergency arise.
- 38. Campers when attending any activities at the campground **you, your family and visitors must wear your wristbands to be allowed to participate**. Such as but not limited to crafts, swimming, bingo, glow ride, etc. Do not expect CRC staff to remember each of you as we have quite the large camper population.
- 39. Note **there** are consequences for not following campground rules which will include issued warnings up to detention at your campsite or when severe non-renewal of your campsite due to failure to abide by rules.
- 40. **Fishing is allowed only in the Montello River** within the campground but not the swimming pond. Note the fish in the pond are part of the water maintenance. **Respect nearby campers and be sure to pick up any trash**.
- 41. Facebook: We have two campground Facebook group pages (1) in near future will only be for campground news posted by Admin and (2) is for all campers with comments allowed where jokes, images, photos and recipes can be shared. No one should comment on any post with mean or disrespectful intentions.
- 42. Lockbox: CRC has a lockbox on the external wall of the office at the patio. Please feel free to share your suggestion of helpful thoughts and ideas. With any area of concern please ask to speak with Jen directly to discuss. For your convenience you may also place payments in the secured lock box.
- 43. Keep your vehicle(s) campground pass visible through front windshield at all times while on property.
