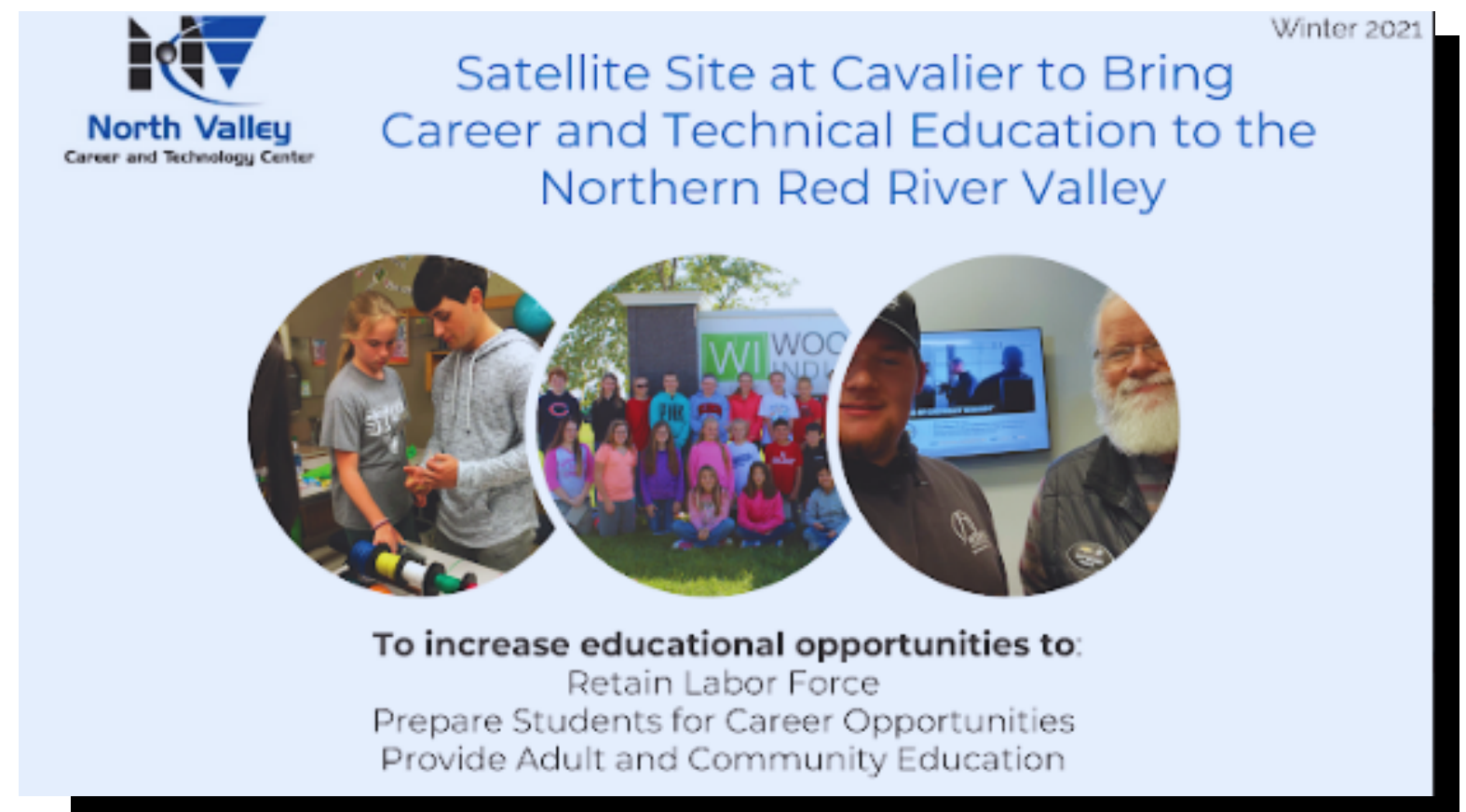
About the District
