What is an ABN?

An Australian Business Number (ABN) is an 11-digit identifier used to identify your business when dealing with customers, suppliers and government.

Why it's important

- Invoice customers
- Open a business bank account
- Register a business name
- Register for GST if required
- Apply for licences

1. Visit the Australian Government Business Registration Service.
2. Check your eligibility.
3. Enter your personal details.
