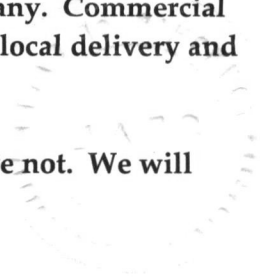
Residents present expressing concerns: Chad Shifko, Joseph Pinskey Jr., Rob Greer, Tim Kepple

Joe Pinskey asked if this would present a problem to his brother, Rob Greer from coming home from work with a tractor trailer. Kerry said it will not be a problem because it is considered local delivery. He is not driving due to construction activity involving many loaded triaxle loads. Farmers are exempt from the restrictions.

Chad Shifko who resides on Quarry Drive, was recently hauling extreme amounts of dirt into his property. Residents advised the Township of the activity and explained that the road is being damaged. Todd visited the site and asked Chad to stop work because the road is posted with a 10-ton weight limit and it should have been bonded. It was determined that Quarry isn’t on the weight restricted road list even though it is posted. That is the reason for this meeting.

Tim Kepple asked how do you determine when it isn’t local delivery? Is it 2 loads or 6? He also questioned if this will be enforced with Orrs. Kerry said that Orrs is a pre-existing business. It is his opinion that we can’t shut them down. The difference is a couple trucks a day vs many. Commercial – vs – residential makes a difference. If you are building a home, that is considered local delivery and the ordinance wouldn’t kick in.

Resident Eric Hageder asked if all the roads have been audited? Todd said they have not. We will add more down the road.

2. ADJOURNMENT


