1. ADMINISTRATION

1A. Motion made by Bob Zundel and seconded by Todd Paulich to approve opening of bids for the purchase of a Tractor with boom mower.

1. Bidder: **West Central Equipment** Bid: \$39,500

No other bids were received. The bid was for a 2008 John Deere 6330 Premium. The bid doesn't indicate if it comes with a boom mower. The Supervisors will inspect before considering purchasing.

Eric Hageder asked if the one we have will be traded. Bob Zundel said the boom will be taken off and the tractor will be used for something else. Eric asked if there was consideration for the type of mower that PennDOT uses that folds up. Todd said they talked about it but a lot of our roads it won't work on.

1B. Motion made by Todd Paulich and seconded by Bob Zundel to hold all Tractor with boom mower bids for award at the supervisor meeting scheduled for March 18th, 2026.

Salem Township, Emergency Management Coordinator Fred Cecchini stated that it has approximately 72,000 miles. It was an Irwin police vehicle. All the decals have been stripped off. It comes with the light and siren. The blue flashing lights would need changed to red. The only concern is that it might have a transmission problem starting to occur. If we have the transmission replaced by someone, Todd said it will cost \$43-4500. It drives and operates without an issue. Todd said that he looked at the vehicle and discussed it with the seller. Since we are a municipality we will get a municipal plate from them. The only other fee is \$400 to transfer the title and plate.

Eric Hageder asked if it will be used for both Fred's positions as Emergency Management Coordinator and Code Enforcement Officer. Kerry said it is supposed to be assigned to the Emergency Management Coordinator for the most part if he uses it for Code Enforcement that is authorized.

Vote on the motion: Kerry Jobe, Bob Zundel, and Todd Paulich voted for the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

- 1D. Motion made by Todd Paulich and seconded by Bob Zundel to extend certain 2025 material procurement agreements.

Kerry said that this pertains to the 2025 COG material bid with Tresco. It is due to expire on April 16, 2025. We are probably going to go move forward with Redstone doing the paving project. If it doesn't happen before then, we aren't going to have "bid" material. After speaking with Ryan and Falco, they said we can do an extension. This has not been discussed with Tresco yet.

Todd said that Redstone is holding the 2025 price and we are supposed to be their first job.

Vote on the motion: Kerry Jobe, Bob Zundel, and Todd Paulich voted for the motion. Motion passed unanimously.
