

LOCAL RULES

1. **Out of Bounds** (Rule 2.1 & 18.2)

A ball is out of bounds:

- a) On or over all boundary walls. Where there is a wall or fence together, the innermost of the two marks the out of bounds.
- b) Beyond the line of the white stakes to the left of the 4th and 13 holes.
- c) In or on the Clubhouse, practice putting green, car parks, and gardens adjacent to the Clubhouse defined by walls, kerb-stones, white stakes and white lines.

2. **Penalty Areas** (Rule 17)

All penalty areas on this course are defined by red stakes.

3. **Roads and Paths**

All artificially surfaced roads and paths are immovable obstructions (Rule 16.1 applies).

4. **Immovable Obstructions Close to Putting Green**

Relief from interference by an immovable obstruction may be obtained under Rule 16.1. In addition, if the ball lies off the putting green but not in a hazard and an immovable obstruction on or within two club-lengths of the putting green and within two club-lengths of the ball intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may take relief as follows:

The ball must be lifted and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay that (a) is not nearer the hole, (b) avoids intervention and (c) is not in a hazard or on a putting green. The ball may be cleaned when lifted. Relief under this Local Rule is also available if the player's ball lies on the putting green and an immovable obstruction within two club-lengths of the putting green intervenes on his line of put. The player may take relief as follows: The ball must be lifted and placed at the nearest point to where the ball lay that (a) is not nearer the hole, (b) avoids intervention and (c) is not in hazard. The ball may be cleaned when lifted.

5. **Stones in Bunkers**

Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions (Rule 15.2 applies).

6. **Ground Under Repair** (Rule 16 - Relief from Abnormal Course Conditions applies)

Any area encircled by a white line and/or marked as G.U.R. is ground under repair from which play is prohibited. If a player's ball lies in the area, or it interferes with the player's stance or the area of his intended swing, the player must take relief under Rule 16.

7. **Protection of Young Trees** (Rule 16 - Relief from Abnormal Course Conditions applies)

Protection of young trees identified by stakes. If such a tree interferes with the player's stance or the area of his intended swing, the ball must be lifted, without penalty, and dropped in accordance with the procedure prescribed in Rule 16. The ball may be cleaned when lifted under this Local Rule.

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULES:

Match play - Loss of hole; Stroke play - Two strokes.
