Organizational Profile

Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity, Inc. is an international association that has become a legacy of excellence. The lineage of greatness began on January 9, 1914, with the three notable founders: Honorable A. Langston Taylor, Honorable Leonard F. Morse and Honorable Charles I. Brown on the campus of Howard University, Washington, D.C. These proud men formed a chain of esteemed scholars striving to make a difference in society through the principles of brotherhood, scholarship and service.

The diversity of their membership was the unique attraction to Sigma with "Culture for Service and Service for Humanity" as the motto. The Brotherhood was able to advance a variety of human causes including civil and equal rights and service to America's communities. Inclusion, rather than exclusion, was the ethical foundation of Sigma's membership. Over 111 years later and with over 225,000 members initiated, the Brotherhood has evolved into one of the nation's oldest African American institutions. Sigma men are the high achievers, movers, and shakers of their times.

Bro. James W. "Chief " Wilson, on the local level, led the way in supporting the Fraternity's programs within the Orlando area. A pillar in the Orlando community for over 60 years, Chief Wilson was responsible for establishing the band at Jones High School. In addition, Chief Wilson served on numerous boards, to include the Central Florida Educators' Federal Credit Union and the Orange County Retired Educators' Association. Gamma Delta Sigma Alumni Chapter of Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity, Inc., started its humble beginning in 1951 through the immense efforts and dedication of Chief Wilson. Gamma Delta Sigma Chapter has flourished because of the foundation established by James "Chief" Wilson. Brother Wilson departed this life on December 5, 2018.

- Sigma Advocacy is an initiative designed to focus on building our collective voice around legislative policies that impact our communities locally, statewide and nationally.
- Continuously register and educate citizens to participate in the democratic process (Project Vote).
- Participate in Relay For Life and other fund raising for the American Cancer Society.
- Support an annual giveaway of 200 turkey dinners and Christmas gifts to needy families in the community.
- The Adopt-A-Precinct (AAP) program is a community partnership program that allows community groups a new way to serve and to raise funds for their worthy causes. We've participated in the program going on eleven years and raising thousands of dollars for scholarships and other important causes.

- All across the country we have mentored thousands of young men since 1950. Our purpose is to support and help develop young men. Participants learn the importance of servicing others and establishing lifelong friendships, as well as the enhancement of meaningful educational and professional opportunities.
