Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity, Inc. is an international association that has become a legacy of excellence. The lineage of greatness began on January 9, 1914, with the three notable founders: Honorable A. Langston Taylor, Honorable Leonard F. Morse and Honorable Charles I. Brown on the campus of Howard University, Washington, D.C. These proud men formed a chain of esteemed scholars striving to make a difference in society through the principles of brotherhood, scholarship and service.

The diversity of their membership was the unique attraction to Sigma with “Culture for Service and Service for Humanity” as the motto. The Brotherhood was able to advance a variety of human causes including civil and equal rights and service to America’s communities. Inclusion, rather than exclusion, was the ethical foundation of Sigma’s membership. Over 112 years later and with over 250,000 members initiated, the Brotherhood has evolved into one of the nation’s oldest African American institutions. Sigma men are the high achievers, movers, and shakers of their times.



### A Lifelong Commitment to Phi Beta Sigma and Orlando Contributions to Education and Music

In 1948 while at FAMU, Chief became a member of Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity Inc. and subsequently in 1951, he was a Charter member of Gamma Delta Sigma, the local Orlando Alumni Chapter of Phi Beta Sigma. Chief Wilson’s influence extended far beyond the Fraternity. For over 67 years, he was recognized as a pillar in the Orlando community. He was instrumental in establishing the band at Jones High School, a milestone that enriched the school’s musical heritage. Chief Wilson’s dedication to education and music inspired countless students at Jones High School; many of them attribute their lifelong passion for music to his encouragement and mentorship.



### Community Leadership and Service

In addition to his work in education, Chief Wilson served on numerous boards, including the Central Florida Educators’ Federal Credit Union and the Orange County Retired Educators’ Association. His leadership was further recognized when he served as President of the Florida Bandmasters Association from 1974 to 1975. In 1989, he was honored with induction into Florida’s Music Educators Hall of Fame, celebrating his outstanding contributions to music education throughout the state.



### Enduring Influence and Legacy

The Gamma Delta Sigma Chapter continues to thrive due to the strong foundation established by Chief Wilson. His legacy lives on in the countless lives he touched and the programs he supported. Brother Wilson departed this life on December 5, 2018, but his impact remains ever-present in the Orlando community and the Fraternity.
