Equality Indiana Applauds Defeat of Mid-Decade Redistricting Bill, Celebrates Statewide Coalition Effort

Indianapolis, IN — December 12, 2025

Equality Indiana celebrates yesterday's vote in the Indiana State Senate defeating HB 1032, the proposed mid-decade redistricting bill that threatened to undermine fair representation for Hoosiers across the state.

"This victory makes one thing clear: when Hoosiers come together, democracy wins," said **G. David Caudill**, Executive Director of Equality Indiana. "Attempts to manipulate political boundaries for partisan gain harm every community — especially marginalized Hoosiers whose voices are already underrepresented. Today, those voices were heard."

Equality Indiana extends deep gratitude to its coalition partners in **All IN for Democracy**, a statewide coalition of nonpartisan organizations committed to protecting fair maps and ensuring every vote counts. Working together, this coalition mobilized thousands of Hoosiers to contact lawmakers, attend events, and demand integrity in our democratic processes.

"LGBTQIA+ Hoosiers know firsthand how essential fair representation is to achieving equality," Caudill continued. "This coalition victory demonstrates the power of civic engagement, partnership, and collective action — and it reinforces why defending democracy and defending LGBTQIA+ rights go hand in hand."
