- First entry and each additional entry of a dog in Agility or Rally, a \$3.50 Service Fee.
- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned
 entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of
 Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or Baray Events

Non-Regular Classes (Involving single dog entries)

VETERAN DOGS (9 yrs. & older) VETERAN BITCHES (9 yrs. & older)

Veteran Class entrants need not be intact. Spayed or neutered dogs/bitches are eligible. Winners of the Veterans Classes, if otherwise undefeated at this show, are eligible to compete for Best of Breed.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed or Variety competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record, or Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the day of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owners' records. Winners of the above Non-Regular Classes may also compete in the Best of Breed Competition, provided that they are undefeated in any Regular Class at this show.

OWNER-HANDLED BEST OF BREED

This event qualifies for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series, Exhibitor MUST check the Owner-Handled checkbox on the entry form to be eligible.

Non-Regular Classes (Involving Multiple Dog Entries) - Show #1 Only

Note: Non-regular classes involving multiple entries may be judged before or after Best of Breed. As the judge's decision in these classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog, no one of the dogs making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed by virtue of having won the class.

Stud Dog Class and Brood Bitch Class: Each entry is allowed two and not more than four get unless otherwise specified. The merits of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch are not considered in the placement of the entry. It is the quality of the get that forms the basis for the judge's decision. All get must be examined and gaited. The Stud Dog or Brood Bitch must also be examined to determine if there is a condition that would require disqualification or excusal under the Rules, AKC policy or the breed standard. All get must be entered in a regular class in order to be eligible to compete in the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch Class. Handlers of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch, and all get being exhibited, must wear armbands. Ch. 11, Sec. 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."

Brace Class: Two Dogs, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in the brace class must have at least one common owner. Dogs do not need to be entered in any other class. Dogs comprising a Brace Class must be named at the time of entry, and full particulars must be given for each dog on individual entry forms. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class only." An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for additional classes as "Brace Class."

SPECIAL RECOGNITION

- Awards of Merit After awarding Best of Breed, the judge may award up to three (3) Awards of Merit based solely at judge's discretion. Awards of Merit are offered at both shows.
- Best Puppy from the 6-9 & 9-12 Classes Chosen from the winners of the Puppy 6-9 and 9-12 classes. If a puppy entrant is chosen Best of Breed or Best of Winners, then it is automatically awarded Best Puppy. (Show #1 only does NOT include the BBE Puppy class winner)
- Best Bred-By Exhibitor Chosen from the winners of the Bred-By-Exhibitor classes. If a BBE entrant is chosen Best of Breed or Best of Winners, then it is automatically awarded Best BBE. (Show #1 only DOES include the BBE puppy class winners)
- Best Veteran Chosen from the winners of the Veterans Dog and Veterans Bitch classes. If a Veteran entrant is chosen Best of Breed, then it is automatically awarded Best Veteran. (Show #1 only)
- Best Stud Dog /Brood Bitch Chosen from the winners of the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Classes. (Show 1 only)
- Best Brace Two Dogs, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two (2) handlers.
 Both dogs competing in the brace class must have at least one (1) common owner. (Show 1 only)

4-6 MONTH BEGINNER PUPPY

Judge: Pat Putnam

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. Classes will be offered for breeds and varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. The Miscellaneous class competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show. The FSS competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show.

Entry and Eligibility

Entry and eligibility requirements include:

- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- A foreign born dog may enter this class if it is registered in the country of origin.
- FSS number or FSS registered litter number will be required for Miscellaneous and FSS breed entries.
- · All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Professional handlers, members of their household and current assistants to professional handlers may personally exhibit a dog they own as "Exhibition Only" in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition. Entries must be marked "Exhibition Only" prior to the close of entries.
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants or household members of a professional handler. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or, assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend. Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition.

CLASSIFICATION - CLASSES COMBINED - PUPPY, 4 & UNDER 6 MONTHS IF ENTRY EXCEEDS 25, A SECOND JUDGE MAY BE ASSIGNED.

NO PUPPIES UNDER THE AGE OF SIX (6) MONTHS, EXCEPT THOSE PARTICIPATING IN THE 4-6 MONTH PUPPY COMPETITION, MAY BE ON THE GROUNDS.

The Sweepstakes is open to all Boston Terriers who are 6 months & under 18 months of age on the day of the show. Champions of Record are NOT eligible for Sweepstakes. Only Professional Handlers who are owners of record may handle dogs in Sweepstakes. All dogs entered in Sweepstakes must also be entered in a Regular Class. Sweepstakes will be judged prior to the Regular Classes. Indicate Sweepstakes and age division on the regular entry form under "Additional Classes." Entry fee is \$22.00.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION - SHOW #1 ONLY

NOVICE CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show.

OPEN CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

BEST JUNIOR HANDLER will be selected from the winners of the three classes. Competition not required.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, 919-233-9767. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.



Dixon May Fairgrounds Requirements

Please read and honor these requirements so that everyone can have a safe show - Thank you

- Per the Fire Marshal: All pop-ups and canopies must be at least 20' away from any building. All tents/canopies should have a tag indicating CPAI-84 compliance
- No mats to be used on the lawn area between the entrance and the concrete bollards (the area between Madden and Denverton Halls)
- Per the Fairgrounds: The use of stakes on the fairgrounds is restricted. It is suggested that exhibitors plan to use weights instead of stakes. Please let the Show Committee know if you should need help with transporting your equipment.
- The use of stakes on lawn 12 (north end of Fairgrounds) is strictly prohibited. All canopies must use weights.
- Golf Carts, gators, quads or other motorized vehicles such as scooters are not to be brought or used on the fairgrounds and cannot be used by participants in the show, except mobility devices. Golf carts are for official show duties only and all drivers must sign the fairgrounds golf cart rules.
- Unloading in the designated area near the show rings, accessed through the south gate
- No unloading/parking in the loop in front of the Fairgrounds office
- A map with all gate, parking, unloading areas and handicapped area will be provided in the judging program and online at sacvalleydfa.com
