## **NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS – ALL EVENTS**



**The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List.**

The American Kennel Club will collect the following at every Licensed or Member club event: • First entry of a dog in Conformation or Obedience, a \$3.00 Event Service Fee and \$.50 Recording Fee, plus a \$3.50 Service Fee for each additional entry of the same dog.

- First entry and each additional entry of a dog in Agility or Rally, a \$3.50 Service Fee.
- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or Baray Events assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. **RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH ENTRANT.**
- **RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE.** BaRay Events will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. We will not re-process checks. The exhibitor will be contacted & required to send a money order for the original amount PLUS the \$30.00 NSF fee. Subsequent returned checks from same person may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
- **REFUNDS** for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed by the Club to said Exhibitor or Agent **AFTER THE SHOW.** An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
- Females in season are not permitted to compete in Obedience or Rally Trials. If a female is withdrawn from competition because it came into season and the Superintendent is notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial, the Clubs is required to refund the entry fee. The Clubs may retain a processing fee and must publish this information in the premium. Clubs may determine the documentation, if any that is required to confirm the female is in season. This shall be stated in the premium. Note: No fee is paid to the AKC for females in season who are withdrawn.
- **FAX ENTRIES** – Fax entries will not be accepted.
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund for **DUPLICATE ENTRIES** or **OVERPAYMENTS.** If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show **NO REFUND** will be made. To find out about any AKC event cancellations call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline 877-252-3229.
- Please note: Any hotel or motel listed in the premium list is subject to Event Committee Rules. We expect our exhibitors to be responsible guests. A report that an exhibitor at this show has abused hotel or motel property during this weekend may result in disciplinary action. Clubs reserve the right to decline future entries from the offending party in accordance with the provisions of Ch. 11, Sec. 15 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendent will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the rings.
- Only dogs eligible for these shows will be admitted into show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs.
- **LOSS OR DAMAGE** – The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Shows. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Additionally, clubs should include any specific local health requirements; for example proof of rabies vaccination.
- **PUBLICATION RIGHTS** – By entering this show, all owners, handlers, breeders and kennels agree that all rights to televise, videotape, photograph, advertise, promote and publicize or otherwise exploit this show, or the persons or animals participating in it or the results of the competition before, during or after the event, shall belong solely to The American Kennel Club and their respective assigns, including the use of the names, likenesses or biographical matter of all dogs, owners, handlers, breeders and kennels participating in the show and no such owner, handler, breeder or kennel shall allow any other party to make commercial use of any videotape or photograph of any person or animal participating in this competition.

**Dixon May Fairgrounds Requirements**

**Please read and honor these requirements so that everyone can have a safe show - Thank you**

- Per the Fire Marshal: All pop-ups and canopies must be at least 20' away from any building. All tents/canopies should have a tag indicating CPAI-84 compliance
- No mats to be used on the lawn area between the entrance and the concrete bollards (the area between Madden and Denverton Halls)
- Per the Fairgrounds: The use of stakes on the fairgrounds is restricted. It is suggested that exhibitors plan to use weights instead of stakes. Please let the Show Committee know if you should need help with transporting your equipment.
- The use of stakes on lawn 12 (north end of Fairgrounds) is strictly prohibited. All canopies must use weights.
- Golf Carts, gators, quads or other motorized vehicles such as scooters are not to be brought or used on the fairgrounds and cannot be used by participants in the show, except mobility devices. Golf carts are for official show duties only and all drivers must sign the fairgrounds golf cart rules.
- Unloading in the designated area near the show rings, accessed through the south gate.
- No unloading/parking in the loop in front of the Fairgrounds office

Neutered Dogs and Spayed bitches may compete in Veterans Classes & may also compete in the Best of Breed Competition, provided that they are undefeated in any Regular Class at this show.

BEST OF BREED

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Variety Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record; and Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owners' records. If at the end of the 90 day period the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by the American Kennel Club, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by AKC.

#### Non-Regular Classes (Involving Multiple Dog Entries) -

*Note: Non-regular classes involving multiple entries may be judged before or after Best of Breed. As the judge's decision in these classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog, no one of the dogs making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed by virtue of having won the class.*

**Stud Dog Class and Brood Bitch Class:** Each entry is allowed two and not more than four get unless otherwise specified. The merits of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch are not considered in the placement of the entry. It is the quality of the get that forms the basis for the judge's decision. All get must be examined and gaited. The Stud Dog or Brood Bitch must also be examined to determine if there is a condition that would require disqualification or excusal under the Rules, AKC policy or the breed standard. All get must be entered in a regular class in order to be eligible to compete in the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch Class. Handlers of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch, and all get being exhibited, must wear armbands. Ch. 11, Sec. 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."

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## **JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION**

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**NOVICE CLASS:** This shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class.

**OPEN CLASS:** For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

**MASTER CLASS:** This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition.

**NOTICE:** Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, 919-233-9767. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

**NOTE: SUBSTITUTION OF DOG IN JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP AT THE SHOW(S):** There will be an Administration Fee of \$5.00 charged for any substitution of dog in Junior Showmanship at each show. In addition, if the dog originally entered in Jr. Showmanship was an additional entry, and the dog being substituted is not otherwise entered in the show, the Junior Showmanship Only fee applies.

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**From Westbound 1-80**, take Hwy. 113 South exit. (Hwy. 113 is First St.). Dixon May Fairgrounds is on the left, one-half mile past the signal at First & A Sts.

**From Eastbound 1-80**, take "Dixon" exit east (to right). This is "A" St. At signal at First & A Sts. (2 miles), turn right onto South First St. at the signal in the middle of town. Go ½ mile to the Fairgrounds on the left.

**AWARDS OF MERIT:** The Judge, may, at his/her discretion, present an Award of Merit Rosette to one dog/bitch for every four entrants who have competed in the Best of Breed judging at this Specialty. Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, and Select Dog/Bitch are not eligible.

**BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR:** The winners of the Bred By Exhibitor Puppy Dogs/Bitches and Bred By Exhibitor Adult Dogs/Bitches classes compete for Best Bred-by Exhibitor. If the winner of any of the mentioned classes was awarded Best of Winners, then the award is automatic.

**BEST PUPPY:** The winners of the regular Puppy classes, Puppy Dogs/Bitches (6-9 Mo., 9-12 Mo.) compete for Best Puppy. If the winner of any of the mentioned classes was awarded Best of Winners, then the award is automatic.

**BEST VETERAN:** Competition is offered for the winners of the Veteran classes. If the winners of any of the mentioned classes is Best of Breed, then the award is automatic.

**BEST NOHS -** After the Best of Breed competition is completed the undefeated eligible owner handlers will compete for Best Owner Handled In Specialty Show.

Hours RV Overnight will be available: Thursday, October 24, 2024 – Noon – 10:00PM; Friday, October 25, 2024 – 6:00AM – 8:00 AM and 3:00 PM – 10:00pm; Saturday, October 26, 2024; 6:00AM – 7:00AM and after Best In Show – 10:00PM; Sunday, October 27, 2024 – 6:00AM – 7:00AM.

OVERNIGHT & DAY OF SHOW PARKING ARE PRIVILEGES OF DIXON MAY FAIRGROUNDS & SACRAMENTO VALLEY DOG FANCIERS ASSOCIATION, INC (SVDFA). THESE PARTIES RESERVE THE RIGHT TO WITHDRAW PRIVILEGES, WITHOUT RETURN OF RV OVERNIGHT PARKING FEE OR ENTRY FEES, FROM ANY PERSON(S) WHO CANNOT ABIDE BY, ABUSES THESE PRIVILEGES OR USES ABUSIVE LANGUAGE. No visitors will be allowed to drive their cars into the overnight reserved parking area.

**PARKING SPACES WILL BE PRE-ASSIGNED. PEOPLE WISHING TO PARK TOGETHER MUST SEND IN THEIR RESERVATIONS TOGETHER, however there is no guarantee that we can accommodate all requests.**

**COST: TWO NIGHT MINIMUM - \$65.00 PER NIGHT / PER SPACE.** Spaces are 22' x 40'. Vehicles over 40' total length or vehicles with a slide out that will not fit in a 22' x 40' space will need to buy 2 spaces. If your entire package will not fit in a 22' x 40' space, you will need to buy additional space. Trailers & tow units may be required to be unhitched. Electric (if available) is very limited, on a first come, first serve basis. However, there is no guarantee that your parking space will have access to electricity. Electric can not be reserved, requested, saved &/or guaranteed. Payment of RV overnight parking fees does not guarantee electricity. Please be prepared if you do not have electricity. No more than 2 vehicles with a total length of 40' per space, this includes tagalong/tow vehicle.

All vehicles will be parked in the same direction in the rows &/or side-by-side &/or head to tail. STRICTLY ENFORCED

### **ATTENTION EXHIBITORS OF FOREIGN DOGS**

Effective August 1, 2024 the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) is expanding requirements for the importation/entry of foreign dogs into the United States. Requirements include that all dogs must be at least 6 months of age, microchipped, complete new CDC Dog Import forms, and have a valid rabies vaccination or be able to demonstrate residence in a DMRVV (canine rabies)-free or low risk country for the last 6 months.
