A resolution of the Board of Commissioners of the Anderson Island Park & Recreation District, Pierce County, Washington, authorizing requests to the Washington State Department of Transportation and other agencies for funds to replace a culvert under Eckenstam-Johnson Road on Anderson Island.

WHEREAS, the District is the steward of approximately one mile of streambed of Schoolhouse Creek on Anderson Island; and

WHEREAS, the District has been engaged in efforts to restore salmon habitat on this creek for the past twenty years; and

WHEREAS, near Wide Awake Hollow, a culvert channeling Schoolhouse Creek under Eckenstam-Johnson Road has blocked access for salmon to the upper portion of the creek and its historic spawning and rearing habitat,

NOW THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE ANDERSON ISLAND PARK & RECREATION DISTRICT, AS FOLLOWS,

That the Board of Commissioners of the District is authorized to seek funds from the Washington State Department of Transportation and other agencies to enable the replacement of the culvert under Eckenstam-Johnson Road near Wide Awake Hollow by such structures as will permit salmon to return to the historic spawning and rearing habitat at the headwaters of Schoolhouse Creek.
