Historical Facts

April, 2008 -- Twilight Golf League founded at Abacoa Golf Club by Jay Osborne. There were 10 teams that first year, 20 teams the second year, 22 teams the third year and 24 teams since 2011. At the end of the 2023 season, three original members were still playing in the league: Jay Osborne, Jimmy Freeburn and Bill Mech.

Low round: 32 recorded on the back nine by Mike Connors on June 3, 2021 and duplicated by David Murray on July 14, 2022.

Second low round: 33 recorded twice by Cory Parkinson in August 2012 and May of 2013. It was matched by Jonas Bloomqvist in May 2018, Mike Connors in July 2020 and Phil Doherty in August 2020.

Double-eagle (albatross): Will Nicoloso -10^{th} hole, a drive and a 6-iron into the cup on June 3, 2016

Hole-in-ones: Jonas Bloomqvist, year-end scramble tournament Oct. 9, 2009 9-iron on 4th hole; Jerami Eggleston, a 6-iron on the 13th hole, July 14, 2016; Dan Boss, 5-hybrid on 13th hole on June 13, 2019; Frank Sobocinski, 8-iron on 4th hole on July 21, 2022. Mike Nardone on 8th hole, June 29, 2023. Hole was playing 187 yards into the wind. He hit a four-iron six inches in front of the hole and watched it trickle in.

Back-to-back deuces: John Hartshorn on holes 3 and 4 on June 17, 2020

Most birdies in one night: 30 recorded by league players on July 30, 2020

Most eagles in one night: 2 Bret Norberto on the 5th hole and Bill Serpa on the 7th hole on May 20, 2021 Also by Eric Cowles and Billy Falconio on the 2nd hole July 15, 2021

Birdies recorded on every hole during a round: May 14, 2020 on holes 1-9 and July 30, 2020 also on holes 1-9; May 19, 2022 on holes 1-9 and holes 11, 13 and 15; May 23, 2024 on holes 1-9.

Most subs used in one night: 18 on July 15, 2021 (three additional subs were noshows)
